URGENT NOTICE RE: INTERSECTION OF LANGFORD DRIVE AND WOY WOY ROAD KARIONG

Residents of Kariong beware. Plans are underway to install a roundabout at this dangerous intersection with little or no consideration given to pedestrians that use this crossing daily, or to those who occupy the lots surrounding this intersection.

ARE YOU WAITING FOR A SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH BEFORE YOU ACT?

What do we stand to lose if this plan goes ahead?

The majority of the car parking that accommodates the progress hall, arts barn, eco gardens, tennis courts and playground (Did you know the current plan allows for a maximum of 14 car parks only!) which may result in diminished use of these facilities.

The very valuable Arts Barn will be demolished! Along with the recent \$35, invested in renovations and repairs AND diminished us of the popular Eco Gardens which provides a valuable sustainability program to the community.

Possible saftety issues for the Rural Fire Brigade and longer response times to emergency situations—this is catastrophic given the Kariong RFS is in the top 5 busiest brigades in NSW.

Safety issues for the families accessing the child care service on Dandaloo Street AND further disconnection from the community and facilities for the children who attend childcare, school and out of school hours care services in Kariong.



KARIONG PROGRESS ASSOCIATION

Firstly we must provide an overview of the special Forum held on July 16th at our Progress hall

in Woy Woy Rd. The organisers appreciated the great attendance by residents which left standing room only. We also thank Mr Chris Holstein MP for attending and addressing those present.

Two major issues were scheduled for discussion, the most urgent that of a safe pedestrian

crossing and traffic control at the intersection of Langford Drive, Woy Woy Rd and Dandaloo Street. Gosford City Council provided the latest detailed plan for a roundabout which was displayed for viewing and pertinent response which was an overwhelming request for traffic lights and a pedestrian crossing as a control system.

This proposal has been supported by a majority of participants to the online surveys, by the Intersection Action Committee, the petitions from the Kariong Neighbourhood Centre and the Kariong Kids Club child minding centre. So we now, obviously, have a community mandate to strongly request a change of direction by Gosford City Council and we, the Progress Association, together with our partners will now put forward a strong representation to provide the desired outcome.

Please note that we will be utilising available media, including electronic resources to seek your ongoing support for this important campaign. The other major item discussed was the proposed revision of the **Development Control Plan for Mt Penang Parklands** as presented to Gosford City Council by the Central Coast regional Development Corporation. This proposal allows for 10 precincts to be created – two of which, the Juvenile Justice and the Kariong Mountains High School are outside areas and not controlled by the Central Coast Regional Development Corporation. Among the thoughts expressed by those present was "where is the Parklands" as encompassed in the area title. A theme which was proven more relevant as the proposed use of this State Government holding is offered for sale. The area most contentious was Area 2 Highway Commercial Precinct which provides an inviting entry ambience to the Central Coast and a most beneficial open space community facility for residents and visitors. Whilst the impingement of high rise development (up to 4 storey) upon the upgrading of the Mt Penang Gardens and great increase in traffic flow, including delivery trucks, adjacent to the High School will become a concern!

An update will be given at the next Progress meeting Wednesday 6th August 8pm in the Progress Hall, Woy Woy Road.





Peace

Over the last few weeks I have been preaching on what the Bible calls the fruit of the Spirit, spoken of in the book of Galatians. Last Sunday we looked at the fruit of the Spirit of peace.

Different people have

different ideas about peace - for me, a day out fishing by myself is about as peaceful a day as I can imagine. For some, peace comes when the kids go back to school! For others it is a walk along the beach, or getting away to the country for a weekend, or sitting down with a good book and a cup of tea.

But this type of peace is situational peace, dependent on our circumstances.

The peace spoken of in the Bible is the peace of Chapter 4 of the book of Philippians talks God. about the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding. A peace that is not situational or circumstantial, but present through the tough times in life, through our turmoils and trials. A peace that comforts us and keeps us standing, when without it we would collapse in a heap and be unable to carry on.

There is an old hymn called It is Well With My Soul, the words of which were written by a wealthy American Christian man. He was happily married, with four daughters and a son. Within a short space of time, his son died, he lost most of his wealth, and his four daughters drowned when the ship they were on sank whilst en route to Europe. His wife survived.

Heartbroken, Spafford boarded a boat that would take him to his grieving wife in England. It was on this trip that he penned those now famous words, When sorrow like sea billows roll; whatever my lot, thou has taught me to say, it is well, it is well with my soul.




