If you have air conditioning don't forget to clean the filters. All those cords, double adapters and power boards could do with a check as well. Only takes a short while to do but could mean saving life and property.

Warning from Police: at a recent meeting with the Gosford Community Policing Unit the officers indicated that an increase in theft from cars at Service Stations was concerning them. They felt that most people after filling up on petrol, proceeded into the Service Station to pay leaving their cars unlocked, which has allowed this particular type of theft to become an increasing problem. The Police are recommending that as a matter of habit you should lock the car as soon as you get out.

Overall, in the Gosford Police Command most areas of crime have been reduced, and certainly the figures for Kariong reflect that, especially in the past 12 months. This has been helped by the fact that regular visits to Kariong are being carried out by the Highway Patrol, which now has Kariong as one of their patrolled areas on each daily shift.

Langford Drive / Woy Woy Road intersection: after a further meeting with Council staff regarding this matter, the Progress Association has written to the Council reaffirming the community resolve for the preferred solution to be a set of traffic lights at this intersection. Following submission of several petitions to the local State Member for Gosford, Mr. Chris Holstein, plus subsequent meetings of residents, the preferred solution is for the complete package costing, as advised, of approximately \$7.7 million. This would serve the obvious traffic flow increase which will be created by Peninsular demographics, the Kariong/West Gosford and Mt Penang Parklands commercial expansions. The lesser acceptable solution of pedestrian-controlled traffic lights would need to be located between Langford Drive and Milyerra Road to allow physical connection between our communities. This has been the minimum premise of this matter since it was raised, being a need of safe pedestrian connection for young families and seniors. We await further response from the Council.

Mt. Penang Development Plan: expressions of interest were called for this site, and applications closed on 12 March. We understand that there have been some submissions, but at this point they have not been disclosed. We are hopeful that the Central Coast Regional Development group will engage in a local community consultation, details of which we would bring you in our next bulletin.

CCTV cameras for Kariong: the Progress Association has been invited to attend an on-site meeting with Council officers to discuss the project and specific camera locations. The proposed locations for the cameras are the Skate Park, and the shopping centres at Mitchell Drive and at Arunta Avenue. The results of that meeting will be reported in our next bulletin, but it is hoped that the installations will occur late April/ early May

Our beautiful vegetable garden has been flourishing over the summer months, providing our OOSH children with fresh produce for




their afternoon tea menu as well as educating them about gardening procedures.


