



CLOSURE OF KARIONG TENNIS COURTS

As discussed in last months column we received an ultimatum from Council to sign a new lease Agreement by 16 June. It is (amongst other unacceptable matters) a demand for half the income from the tennis courts, which would mean an increased fee structure.

On 14 June, the Council gave the Association a further 14 days to sign the new lease Agreement. Then on 1 July a final extention of 14 days to sign a new and slightly modified, but still unacceptable document, which the Association still felt unable to agree to. Legal advice has confirmed the Association's view that the Agreement was not in a form that could be accepted.

The Association has advised Council of that decision, via the Solicitor, and as the deadline has now passed the Kariong Progress Association is no longer responsible for the tennis courts. It is most probable that the Council will call for "Expressions of Interest" for anyone else interested in taking over the Courts.

The Association had previously written to the Council Administrator expressing its concern about the proposed Agreement, but no reply was received by the deadline date.

LANGFORD DRIVE / WOY WOY ROAD INTERSECTION

Lucy Wicks, local Member for Robertson has had \$675 thousand pledged, and has advised the Association that she has had confirmed to her, by the Central Coast Council Administrator, that he has allocated the balance of funds to have work commence on the intersection, at a date to be advised.

The Association had obtained a copy of the proposed work, and it was discussed at the July meeting. We did ask in the previous 'Connection' if anyone would like to join us at the July meeting to discuss this, and the Tennis Courts matter, but other than the usual attendees, no one appeared.

What this event is all about is for local brigades to start their preparation for the forthcoming fire season or Bushfire Danger Period starting on October 1st. This is also an opportunity for the locals to come up to the station and ask all those questions about bushfire safety & survival.

A Safe Home for Life Family and Community Services and the Broader Community

Every child deserves a permanent and stable home for life, but here on the Central Coast, many children and young people are living in unsafe households. In order to reduce the number of kids at risk FACS identified that a collaborative response from a range of agencies was required.

One response is the establishment of the Central Coast Multi Agency Response Centre (CC MARC), a collaborative approach to managing child protection reports. By calling the state-wide Child Protection Helpline on 132 111 and selecting option 4, calls for the Central Coast are diverted to CC MARC where local caseworkers from FACS, Health, Education and the Family Referral Service can assess a matter quickly and effectively to provide the most appropriate response. This will help ensure the right kids get the right support at the right time, reducing the number of children slipping through the cracks.

Another response is the establishment of a new mobile service called 'The BUS'.

The BUS - **T**ogether **H**elping **E**veryone **B**etter **U**tilise **S**ervices, is an innovative and exciting outreach youth centre - on wheels! Operated by Regional Youth Support Services, it will reach out to communities that don't easily connect with agencies or services due to geographical barriers and other risk factors.




