The last time I wrote this newsletter we were in the midst of a heat wave. By the time the Connection came out we were in the middle of two weeks of rain. And now, we're about to experience another blast of heat so, as I said before folks, you just can't pick the weather.

Never the less, I want to raise another issue with you all which is straight out of the Bushfire Survival Plan, which is being prepared. Here's another question for you..." What's it mean to be prepared?" The BSP covers all that however, you need to understand what it means and to what level you're prepared to go to. A lot of times, folk say that they would rather "stay & defend" and that's a BIG call to make and unless you're ready for what's coming at you and what you need to do prior, then having a well-defined plan for you and your family is vital. Even if you decide that you'd rather leave early, that still comes with another level of preparedness that you need to be aware of because in a time of crisis, decision making is a lot harder than when it's quiet. I can tell you, working out a BSP will make all the difference because when the "proverbial" hits the fan at least you'll have an idea of what to do. Bushfire Survival Plans are available from your nearest fire station or the Emergency Operations Centre on Woy Woy Road or call 43402911 to make an enquiry.

During November, the brigade attended the Central Coast Kids Day Out held at Kariong Mountains High School. It was a great event for everyone and being a warm day, we were popular when it came to hose drill. Just about everyone had a turn at using the fire hose (and giving the grass a bit of water as well) and going through the trucks. There was lots to be seen both from the RFS and Fire Rescue NSW and I'm sure a lot of people came away better informed.
