#### Innovation and Creativity vs NAPLAN

We have just recently finished NAPLAN testing and although this diagnostic tool provides useful information about literacy and numeracy, at a moment in time, it is far down the scale of the skill set that is recognised as being important for the success of our future business acumen, on a global stage. Regardless, with the focus on this one test, it would be easy to teach to this and forget about really making an impact and helping students to gain skills in innovative and creative thinking.

Developing these skills takes time and structuring the curriculum to nurture them. What does this mean? Well, it means engaging students in different types of learning, encouraging them to take risks and providing authentic ways to make learning relevant. These experiences may not be traditional, but to move forward you have to break with tradition.

Does your child's learning experiences look exactly like yours, apart from using computers rather than pen and paper? If yes, that should not make you feel comfortable, but instead it is worrying if our schools operate like this. The world today is different from 30-40 years ago. Then, our advice would have included "learn typing - it is a useful skill and would always get you a job "; today, is that the same advice you would give your child? No, of course not. So today, education should also look different. Foundation skills, yes, but a focus on facts? When you can learn to do most things from a YouTube clip, isn't learning how to interpret information a far more valuable skill to have?

So, back to NAPLAN and our traditional learning patterns, yes they have a place, but leading with an innovation and creativity agenda is more about lifelong learning and this, more than NAPLAN should be what we value. At Kariong Mountains High School, we are paying attention to this agenda. We are in the early stages of this journey, but I am proud of my staff for their passion and commitment to furthering their own learning in these areas, to better prepare our students for life.

**AUSTRALIANS HAVE HAD A WIN.** Gambling advertising is to be banned during live televised sporting events.

Concerns about the negative impacts of gambling advertising have been growing and research shows that adolescents, young men and problem gamblers are especially influenced by gambling marketing.

Many sporting events, teams and stadiums have entered into commercial marketing arrangements with corporate bookmakers. This "gamblification" of sport promotes gambling as harmless fun that, like sport, relies primarily on skill. Advertisements often attempt to elicit emotional responses, such as triggering memories of pleasant or exciting times and emphasising winning. These ads rarely provide harm minimisation information, apart from the 'Gamble Responsibly' slogan.

The good news is that ads will be banned from live sporting events on TV and radio. The ban covers on-screen promotions, sponsorships and live crosses to betting companies for updates on odds during matches until 8.30pm. So you can watch the footy and cricket with your children without being bombarded by gambling ads.

# Standpipe

Hi all, I'm back with more news from the Dandaloo St. Fire Station.



Now that Autumn is with us, you'll be seeing a bit of smoke in the air with hazard reductions being carried out around the area. Some cool dry weather makes ideal conditions for these operations to take place when strategic areas can be safely burned to lower fuel loads before summer and the heat is with us again. However, if you see an unattended fire with no personnel or appliances about then call Triple Zero 000 and report it.

Now, I need to talk to you about a fire fighters best friend. Often overlooked and uncared for. For some an eye sore. It's your humble fire hydrant. Now, I know that this is a delicate subject particularly if you're an avid gardener and like to keep your front lawn in pristine condition but at the end of the day it is an important piece of infrastructure that helps firefighting operations immensely. Kariong brigade members have been out and about lately finding, cleaning & tidying them and I'm hearing some unfavourable reports of hydrants being turfed over, over grown and generally not looked after. If you do have one out front of your place, give it the respect it deserves by keeping it tidy so fire fighters can find them easily. There's nothing more frustrating than playing "Let's Find the Hydrant" at one o'clock in the morning with a hydrant bar, punching holes in the ground listening for that distinctive "ping" of a hydrant lid, buried under some awesome turf while someone's

house slowly burns to the ground. Trust me folks, the turf will be dug up anyway so do your humble firies a favour; be proud of your hydrant.

Keep it neat. Keep it tidy and keep it visible.

Lastly, there was a Medal Ceremony held in the Wyong district to acknowledge the volunteers from across the Coast who give up their time to be in the NSWRFS. Michael Hughes from Kariong Brigade received a 20 year service clasp to his Service Medal. Mick has put in some hard yards with the Rural Fire Service over the years and is a well and worthy recipient of this award.

## **Social Media and Young People**

It is no surprise that young people are being affected now, more than ever, by cyber-bullying.

Due to the instant and frequent access to mobile phones and the internet, cyber-bullying is common and can occur on any of the many social media networks. People can be bullied from someone they know directly and can also be bullied anonymously. The repetitive nature of cyber-bullying can increase the mental health issues among young people and has even resulted in suicide for some young people.

When an individual is being bullied online, they often do not tell others, or are told to not tell others and isolates them in the cyber world.

#### In order to stay safe on social media remember to:

- Manage your privacy settings
- Be selective about your friends, do you really know them?
- TAKE CARE
- Block people if you feel that you are being harassed
- Always think before you post as you can't always take it back

If you or anyone who you know is being harassed or bullied online please contact kidshelpline 1800 55 1800 Another current issue occurring on social media is the sending and receiving of sexual and explicit photos via 'Snapchat', 'Instagram' and 'Facebook'. It is important to remember that **consent** for sharing pictures is essential before any pictures are sent. Many young people can become caught in the vicious cycle of forwarding pictures of somebody else without the consent of the person in the photo, as this behaviour can be viewed as 'normal' by the young people in that group. However young people are not aware of the consequences that result from sharing sexual or explicit images for the person in the picture and the sender. Mental health issues for the victim, suspension and expulsion from school and possibly in the future potential charges of assault and harassment can be the result.



If you or a friend have sent an explicit photo to someone via social media and now regret it:

**Stay calm** - ask them to delete the image or if you have the option to 'untag' yourself if it has been shared on social media, report it and ask trustworthy friends to help 'untag' and report if it has been spread.

**Report it** - to the social media network, teacher or trusting adult

**Don't panic** – don't do anything rash, try to stay calm
If the image has spread, and you know your parents will
eventually find it out, telling them may be an option, there
is an online resource for parents. If it helps get a relative or
sibling to support you when telling your parents.

If police are involved, be honest, who was involved, where it was sent and whether consent given.

**TAKE CARE** – turn your phone off, check your privacy settings, block people who are harassing you, don't follow pages that make you feel unhappy about yourself or your appearance


