PUBLIC MEETING REPORT

NATIONAL BROADBAND NETWORK (nbn)

Rollout in Kariong update

On Monday 19 December Lucy Wicks, local Federal Member, convened a public meeting at Kariong Mountains High School to explain the several delays to the rollout of nbn services, which has been frustrating local businesses and residents. Two representatives from nbn also attended the meeting.

nbn had advised Lucy Wicks of a significant issue preventing it from safely delivering the fibre into this area. It seems that to complete the rollout, nbn must make use of existing conduits that feed from the exchange in Gosford. However, the existing conduits run through private land and despite nbn's best efforts, a local landowner is refusing access to their land, meaning that nbn has been unable to survey existing underground conduits.

nbn submitted a case to the Telecommunications Industry Ombudsman to have the access refusal overturned. The TIO is in the process of preparing her final decision as at the time of going to press.

Lucy Wicks agreed to provide information when it came to hand from nbn, and suggested keeping up to date with her on Facebook / Twitter / lucywicks.com.au


Australian Plant Society



I'm back with some more news from the Dandaloo Street Fire Station.

Well, for the last 3 months' fire activity has been slowly building up to what we saw on February 12th when conditions in parts of the state were at severe to catastrophic levels. Some describe it as like standing in front of a blast furnace with a raging hot nor-wester blowing in your face; The results from that were horrific. Houses destroyed, stock & equipment losses but thankfully no lives lost. At the time of writing, inspections were still being carried out so the damage bill will run into the millions. Unfortunately, folks it's a fact of life on the land and it's a stark reminder that events such as this can strike and the effects can be devastating. But in true Australian spirit there are those who put everything aside to help those in desperate need from the emergency service members both paid and volunteer to the welfare agencies and even down to Mr & Mrs Joe Citizen all putting their hand up to help in those communities.

Folks, how these fires started is up to the investigators so it's best not to speculate however, it should serve as a timely reminder to all of us who live next to some of the most picturesque bushland in the state that vigilance and preparedness is the price we must pay to live here. You can never discount the fact that it could have Kariong in the firing line so again I must say to you all, be prepared. Have your **Bushfire Survival Plan** organised. Ask questions.... you can go to ANY fire station and ask to your hearts content. What I'm trying to say folks that it's better to be part of the solution rather than being part of the problem.

As always folks, Kariong Rural Fire Brigade is in Dandaloo Street Kariong, next to the tennis courts. We're open Wednesday nights from 7.30pm and Saturday mornings from 8.00am. You're welcome to come up and have a yarn with us.

Healthy Relationships

Talking with your partner about sexual health and contraception may seem difficult, but it's an important part of forming a healthy relationship.

It's important to discuss if either of you has had a sexually transmissible infection (STI) in the past (your sexual history) and it's a good idea for you **both** to have a sexual health check-up.

Approximately 1 in 20 young Australians has an STI at any one time. You can get a sexual check-up from your GP. BUT you need to ASK for it clearly, for example, "Can I get a full STI screen today". It's free from your bulk billing. If you are 14 years or over you can give permission for the GP to test you for these infections. Remember, that if an STI's isn't treated it could cause damage to the body and lead to health problems.

Most STI's have no symptoms and you won't know that you have one until you have a test. Most are treated simply with antibiotics. STI's are passed from one person to another during sexual activities that involve direct skin to skin contact and/or exchange of bodily fluids.

Look after our health and the health of our partner by having regular sexual health checks. *See your GP*.


