

The Arts and Crafts Group is passionate about sharing their skills with a new generation. They enjoy the relaxation and pleasure of making special items, when a mass produced item just does not quite fit the bill. Special gifts for a bride and groom or for a new baby are always welcomed.

Nostalgia for the past keeps old traditions flourishing. In the UK in the late 1800s, knitting classes were required for students to prevent a complete loss of the art. Lace making is having a revival in areas of Spain and Malta, as it is proving to be of great benefit to arthritic fingers. We seem to have finally come full circle and are experiencing a revival of many crafts.

A sense of calm sets in when one is crocheting. Unusual wools and cottons are available in beautiful colours and intriguing textures. Many people, male and female, enjoy this craft and knitting was a man's trade between the 1400s and the 1600s. Boys had to serve under an apprenticeship for 6 years. Women still cleaned and spun the wool and did some at-home knitting. (The Craft Group has a spinning wheel for you to try.)

Lace making and quilting have been popular down the ages and we all know someone who is a great quilter. The Craft Group has enthusiastic lace makers and quilters - come and meet them on Thursday mornings - they would love to chat with you over a cup of tea. While you are there check out a variety of crafts, beads, baubles, and dolls in the display cabinet.




