IT'S A TESTING TIME

This time of the year sees students finalising their assessments and/or undergoing end of year exams. For some students, this is a period of great stress as they are committed to doing their best, but worried that they won't achieve to the level expected by themselves, their school or families.

The feedback we give students about their results is an important factor in determining how they proceed on their educational journey. Andrew Martin (psychologist), in his book "How to Motivate Your Child", encourages the use of personal benchmarks (or in sporting parlance, personal bests). Although knowing where a child sits in comparison to others has its place, having your child compete against themselves, with achievable goals to which they are striving, will lead to greater success in the long run. Additionally, research has shown that students who are praised for their effort are more likely to take on new challenges and succeed better at them, than students who are only praised for coming 'top of the class'.

Andrew Martin concludes that "recognising what your child does on the way to getting his or her marks can be just as or more important than the marks themselves". In the end, it will be the perseverance, positive work ethic and curiosity about learning that will be important to the lifelong success of our students, not the mark they got on one report card in one school year. So as those grades come in, we should praise our students for their efforts in improving their results from those they have achieved in the past and challenge them to go even further in the next assessment period.

BROADBAND FOR SENIORS INFORMATION

Kariong Neighbourhood Centre is a buzz of activity with lots of people coming and going. The Centre hosts a number of services and courses to support and connect their community.



Kariong has been designated as a *Kiosk Host* for **Broadband for Seniors** which provides senior Australians, aged 50 years and over, with a friendly and secure environment to receive computer and Internet training.

Access Training at a Kiosk

The Broadband for Seniors ONLINE LESSONS allows you to work entirely at your own speed and it's easy to jump from place to place in the lessons to remind yourself of something you may have forgotten. Everyone learns at their own pace.

Senior Australians visiting a Broadband for Seniors kiosk will have access to the Broadband for Seniors '*Your Resource Kit*'. This kit was specifically designed for seniors. The lessons within the kit can be used for one-on-one or group training with a Volunteer Tutor, or to take home to use on your own computer. The Kiosk is only manned with a tutor if there is a booking made.

Getting started

If a senior phones or drops into the Centre asking to learn something about computers their contact details are noted and they are assured that someone will be in touch. They are then contacted by the coordinator to discuss their needs, expectations and lesson times. A training time is then booked. The Coordinator will then contact the Volunteer Tutor that is rostered on in the agreed time and day, advising details of the client's needs and confirms their roster time. The volunteer comes in only if there is an appointment. This avoids volunteers wasting their valuable time.

Our team of 4 wonderful Volunteer Tutors are all well informed with good communication skills who give their valuable time FREE to teach Broadband for Seniors.



We attended 41 call outs in October; of those there was 11 Fires. 8 Motor Vehicle Accidents. November 1 to 20, there has been 22 callouts, 5 fires, 6 MVAs. Please be careful on the roads. Slow down in the wet, don't go over the speed limit and don't use your mobile whilst driving...... It's just not worth it!

We have had the opportunity to place some donation boxes around the businesses of Kariong and West Gosford. If you happen to see a box and have some loose change please pop it in the box. We appreciate and thank you sincerely.
