All our Homestay Families in the program are accredited through a process involving site visits, interviews, documentation, referee and Working with Children Checks and become part of the "NAISDA Family".

Ours calls for the past three months 'til 20<sup>th</sup> November total 69 and are as follows: False Alarms x 5, Fire and Explosions x 26, Good Intent Calls x 1, MVA's x 22, Hazardous Conditions x 5, Other x 10.

As I am typing on the keyboard, the temperature outside is tipping 40 degrees. Our Fire Danger Sign is set at SEVERE Level and there is a TOBAN (Total Fire Ban) in place .... The weather patterns indicate there are going to be a lot more mid to high 30s with a few 40+ days thrown in. The recent fires have shown how quickly a bushfire can take off.

We along with other agencies spend hours training, maintaining the equipment, community education etc etc. We are on call 24/7 to assist our Community to keep safe. The Brigade applied for a grant from the Rural Fire Service Association and was successful. We were in need of a few pieces of equipment. A huge thank you to the RFSA for providing the means for us to purchase the equipment which will make our job safer.

I have listed below a few memory joggers for you to keep in mind in the Holiday Season – # Fill in and practice your Bushfire Survival Plan. # Ensure all family members know what to do in the event of a fire. # Tell your extended family your plan and if you plan to leave, let them know how or where to contact you. # Encourage those you love – friends and family to fill out and practice their plan. # Prepare your property. # Know the various advice levels used in relation to fires. # Know where your neighbourhood safe area is located. # Report any suspicious behaviour in or around bushland. (Triple 000). # Report acts of arson immediately. (Triple 000). # If you spot an unattended fire please call triple 000 and where possible provide the nearest cross street or landmark. # Keep an eye on Fires Near Me to ensure you keep up to date with what's happening around you. Download the free app to your phone. # Keep fire hydrants visible at all times. # Please leave extra water out for your pets and wildlife.




