THE GAME OF BRIDGE:

Bridge is a challenging game which can be played at many levels, from a friendly social game to highly competitive duplicate sessions. Many keen players also compete in other Clubs throughout NSW and inter-state. There are over 150 (Affiliated) Bridge Clubs in NSW, including 4 on the Central Coast.

There is no age barrier to playing bridge and it can be played regardless of the weather. Bridge is considered to be a great way to exercise the grey cells and to ward off Alzheimer's. It is not expensive to play.

Bridge is also a means of instantly having access to a community if you travel or move house. During a recent visit overseas we played in America and were warmly welcomed and provided with transport to the venue and back to our hotel.

The game can trace its origins back to the early 16th Century in England. It has been known in a variety of forms, and referred to by various exotic names such as Triumph, Trump, Ruff, Slam, Whisk, Swabbers and Whist. It is not clear how it became "Bridge" although a pamphlet in the British Museum 1886 refers to "Biritch or Russian Whist".

The use of playing cards for leisure however goes back to about 969 AD in China where a pack was divided into four suits with fourteen cards each. Tradition has it that a relative of Marco Polo brought cards back from China to his native Venice in about 1269.

Bridge is played in over 100 countries throughout the world and is believed to have over 60 million players worldwide. If you have ever enjoyed playing "500" or "Euchre" you will probably love bridge. It takes longer to learn the rudiments of the game and then you continue to learn for however long you play. This is what makes it so fascinating and keeps people playing all their lives.

Omar Sharif was reported to have said" Acting is my profession, breeding race horses is my hobby, but **Bridge is my passion**". I understand what he means.



G'day all. I'm back with more news from Kariong Rural Fire Brigade. Firstly, I hope you all had a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. Right now the lead topic in the media and on most people's minds are the bushfires burning across the state and the tragedies that have befallen residents in the Shoalhaven and in the Central West of NSW. And not only there but also in Victoria, South Australia and Tasmania bushfires have burnt out thousands of hectares of bushland and destroyed property. I was only saying to a few of my fellow fire fighters whilst on stand-by during a couple of Total Fire Bans a little while ago, that we have really dodged the bullet around the Central Coast for any fires. Luckily for us the fire activity locally has been minimal however not so elsewhere. Fire bugs exhibit the worst of human nature because of the wilful damage and destruction they can cause because of the potential damage that can occur because of this criminal act so help catch them and put them away.

Another issue that has raised its head lately is the old cigarette butt flicker. Folks, every car has an ash tray, if you are a smoker please use it. There is nothing that gets me more annoyed than to see a lit cigarette butt carelessly flicked out of moving a car. Tossed into tinder-dry grass or bush and with a little breeze and you've got yourself a fire. Not only is it silly it'll cost you if detected by the Police because there are some sizable fines that will be imposed on you if found guilty particularly during a Total Fire Ban day.

People if all that has unfolded throughout the country hasn't convinced you to get your Bushfire Survival Plan organised that I don't know what will. Don't ever think that dangerous fires won't happen around Kariong and surrounding districts. Do your friendly firies a huge favour and get on the net and download your plan from the MyRFS web site. If you don't do computer then get up to your local fire station and get all your info from the fire fighters there. I don't want to alarm anyone but it makes sense to be organised and if the worst happens, you'll know what you need to do.

Finally folks, I've got to acknowledge the members of Kariong brigade for their commitment and dedication during times of TOBAN. I've got to tell you that it's not easy to man a station for anything up to twelve hours, mostly in hot uncomfortable weather but these guys are prepared to do it for their community. You can't get much better than that.

That's it folks. Stay safe and be Firewise.


