

#### Lifestyle & Prescriptions

Go to a doctor these days and you are increasingly likely to get a prescription that you will fill at the greengrocer or the fitness gym rather than the local chemist.

This move recognises that while prescription drugs have an important role to play, they are fighting an uphill battle if it is our lifestyle that is making us sick in the first place. As most prescription drugs have some sort of side effect (even if it is only a financial one!) it makes sense to only take such remedies when we have to; and since the only side effect of lifestyle prescriptions is good health, the sooner we are on such prescriptions, the better - prevention is better than cure! We must also avoid falling into the trap of thinking that healthy activities like exercise have only specific, targeted benefits like prescription drugs. Instead we need to remember that exercise has a holistic effect. When selecting exercise to keep or maintain ones health, there should therefore be a different focus than in using exercise just to prove one is 'fit'.

Exercises should not exhaust, nor should they put the body systems such as joints and the cardiovascular system at risk. Exercises such as Tai Chi have been shown to be beneficial in helping prevent or alleviate many conditions - arthritis; asthma; depression; osteoporosis; cardiovascular and back problems to name a few.

Tai Chi is also one of the safest exercises to perform. Local student Maree started Tai Chi after sustaining a serious back injury at work which left her unable to stand for periods of more than twenty seconds. "...I learnt for the first 12 months sitting in a chair" she says. "It is very beneficial. A gentle exercise, it also helps with pain management. In this time I have improved a lot and have been able to return to work... and [I] encourage a lot of people to take up Tai Chi". "It is a wonderful hour each week". Not a 'cure-all', but certainly a 'help-all', Tai Chi is an holistic lifestyle prescription that has something to offer all ages and abilities. Plus, it is interesting, social, and fun to do!

## Kariong Progress Association

Kariong Crime Stats will resume in the next issue.

Langford Drive / Woy Woy Road intersection: the report prepared by the consultants for Gosford Council has been forwarded to RMS. The final details are not yet known, but in view of the upcoming State Government election in March, we feel it is important that as many people as possible write to the current local Member, Chris Holstein, requesting that he support the plan, and that the Government will provide the appropriate funding.

Considering the amount of publicity over the past few months regarding the flow of funds to the Western Suburbs of Sydney, it needs to be brought home to the Government that the Central Coast needs funds urgently to catch up. This particular intersection has been discussed for a long time now, and we need to have a resolution, and the local Member should indicate clearly that he supports the traffic light proposal, and the State Government will provide the funds. The more contact the local Member has from the public will be an indication to him that we have expectations of him that he will meet.

<u>Mt. Penang Development Plan</u>: the amended Plan has been approved by Gosford Council. Basically it changes little, except to accommodate some concerns expressed by this Association, the Historical Society and other interested parties. The historical areas and the gum trees have been retained, but the type of use (retail/ business) remains unchanged. One concern by this Association, not addressed, is the traffic flow at the intersection of the Central Coast Highway and The Avenue if retail and business are to go ahead. This is an issue for discussion at the February Association meeting.

<u>Mount Penang swimming pool</u>: no further action on this at present, but see the specific Facebook page...Bring Back Mt Penang / Kariong Public Swimming Pool.

<u>Tennis Courts</u>: both Courts are now fully functional, and have enjoyed constant use over the holiday period. To make a booking you can contact Yvonne on 4340 1068, between 8.30am and 6.30pm.

<u>CCTV cameras for Kariong:</u> a detailed report is now in preparation, and will be discussed fully at the Association meeting in March.

# Kariong Medical Centre would like to advise of changes to the cost of a consultation to patients as of the 1<sup>st</sup> March 2015.

The new co-payment that the government is planning to implement in July has caused the Doctors at Kariong Medical Centre to make the decision to change from a Bulk billing practice to a Mixed billing practice. The change will affect consultations only. Each consultation will be assessed on a case by case basis, therefore, you will need to come prepared to pay for your consultation. Children under 16 years will still be Bulk Billed. Doctors have for two years absorbed the cost of administering the Practice without an increase in the Medicare fee, but are unable to continue to do this.

# **Private Fees:**

Consultation Level A: \$45.00 (Medicare rebate \$16.95) Saturday: \$50.00

Consultation Level B: \$65.00 (Medicare rebate \$37.05) Saturday: \$70.00

Consultation Level C: \$95.00 (Medicare rebate \$71.70) Saturday: \$100.00

Consultation Level D: \$125.00(Medicare rebate \$105.55) Saturday \$130.00

Payment is to be made at the time of the consultation. We are able to submit your Medicare claim for the rebate online, and the rebate will be deposited into your account within 2 working days following the consultation.

# Shortage of Appointments

As a number of you will have experienced recently, getting an appointment to see your Doctor on the day you require one is becoming more difficult. If you have a regular need to see the Doctor (ie. Prescriptions etc), you will need to book ahead to avoid disappointment.

# **Appointments**

If you have multiple issues to discuss with your Doctor, please be sure to ask the receptionist to make a longer appointment for you. Appointments must be made for each person attending a consultation. This will help Doctors to keep on time.

# New GP's

At the beginning of February we will welcome two new registrar Doctors to the Medical Centre, Dr. Sarah Gunn and Dr. Jaydeep Ubeja who will be working here for the next 6 months.

# **Health Assessments**

Did you know that the government encourages GP's to undertake the following health assessments to provide Doctors with the opportunity to identify risk factors and to talk to their patients about preventative measures to reduce chronic disease: 4 Year Healthy Kids Check (once only before 5years of age). Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Annual Health Assessment (Aged 0 – 75 years) 45 - 49 Year Health Checks (once only) 75 Year plus Annual Health Assessment (These assessments will be Bulk Billed to Medicare)

If you believe you are eligible for one of these Health Assessments please speak to your Doctor or phone and speak to our reception staff about booking in for one at your next visit.


