

1. THE INTERSECTION AT LANGFORD DRIVE AND WOY WOY ROAD; IF THE RMS CONTINUE TO INSIST ON A ROUNDABOUT, IT WILL BE ALMOST IMPOSSIBLE

FOR PEDESTRIANS TO CROSS THIS ROAD SAFELY. CHILDREN USING THE CROSSING TO ATTEND SCHOOL WILL BE IN DANGER AS NO PROVISION FOR PEDESTRIANS IS INCLUDED IN THE CURRENT DESIGN.

- 2. MOUNT PENANG PARKLANDS AND THE PROPOSED SELLOFF; THIS MATTER IS STILL ONGOING AFTER SEVERAL YEARS, AND THE COMMUNITY HAS PROVIDED SEVERAL SUBMISSIONS TO THE CURRENT PROPOSAL BY THE CENTRAL COAST REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. 

Last month was another quiet month for call outs for the Brigade. From 21st



May until 18th June we have had 29 calls: - 4 x False Alarms, 4 x Fires, 5 x Good Intent, 2 x Hazardous Conditions, 4 x Miscellaneous and 10 x Motor Vehicle Accidents which equates to a huge 36% of the calls for the month.

Have you and your family discussed a home escape plan in the case of a fire in your home? It's a good idea to have a meeting place outside the home and practice how to evacuate your dwelling in a safe and calm way.

Did you know that half of all kitchen fires start from unattended cooking? If you have to leave the kitchen, turn the stove right down, and if you leave the kitchen with the oven going make sure you set a timer (maybe use your mobile phone) so you don't forget.

Always turn your heater off before going to bed. Check the condition of power points, electrical cords and appliances on a regular basis. If it looks a little sus, don't use it until you get it checked over.

Before the fire season commences on October 1, the Brigade would like to hold informal workshop/s for the Ladies of Kariong. The Women's Program will consist of basic fire awareness within the home and surrounds. The workshop/s will provide support and advice along with some hands on activities. The aim of the Program is to give women the confidence to successfully prepare their families and properties for bush and house fires. At this stage, we are asking for expressions of interest. 
