

# KARIONG MOUNTAINS

Our first Connection article for the year! I hope your children have had a good start back at school. We have had a great start to the year, with our student numbers increasing above expected due to new enrolments and the number of school leavers at an all-time low. I would like to think that this is linked to our school values of **'unity knowledge respect'** as being seen as more than just a motto, but the foundation of who we are and how we operate.

Congratulations to our Year 12 2015 graduates. Once again, students have gained entry into a variety of university and TAFE courses, as well as employment and apprenticeships.

From Term 4 last year, we were able to create a Head Teacher Wellbeing position using Gonski funding. Already, the impact has been greater structure and support for students and feedback is very positive from students, staff and families. On the academic front, our first cohort of accelerated students in the Year 10 selective stream, has begun their Year 11 studies in Science, bringing to fruition a plan that has been in place since 2010.

We have continued to respond to the needs of students and our subject choices are driven by student demand, not school timetables or teacher preferences. For this reason, 2016 has seen the introduction of 'Outdoor Recreation' as a Stage 5 elective and the introduction of the 'Visual Design' course in Stage 6. We are the only school in the State with a rugby elective and it has grown in popularity as it enters its second year of implementation.

In co-curricular activities, we now have both robotics and makerspaces operating for students with an interest in these STEM related areas, as well as a wide range of sporting teams from which to choose.

#### Kariong Progress Association CONCERN ABOUT THE FUTURE OF THE



The Gosford Council is proposing a new 3-year Community License which would see the Council taking half the hiring income of the tennis courts. <u>This could mean a doubling of</u> <u>the current hiring charges</u>. You will probably have noticed that the Council has placed traffic flow counting equipment along Woy Woy Road. This is to update their current information prior to further decisions being made.

#### **POLICE CONCERN continued**

In last month's edition of the Connection there was a full page notice from Gosford Police. Since that edition we have had some comments regarding the Police Assistance Line. You can call PAL to report minor crimes that have already been committed (crimes that are not in progress) and which do not involve traumatized victims, or require urgent attention or immediate Police attendance. For example, steal from motor vehicle, stolen motor vehicles, graffiti, malicious damage, and break and enters. When you ring PAL, they will take the details of the crime, and make them available to local Police for analysis and action. As we said last month, Police stress that all reports are recorded, and over a period they can build up a profile of events, or concerns, that they can act on.

And don't forget that there is a book at the Neighbourhood Centre that you can also express your concerns. And you can use that book to let us know of the results of your Police contact.


