Tips for car security

- 1. Don't keep valuables and personal items in your car.
- 2. Make sure all windows are closed and doors are locked, even when your car is parked at home.
- 3. Keep all valuables out of sight.
- Leave nothing in plain sight that may make your 4. car interesting to a thief.
- 5. If you park in a garage make sure you lock it.
- 6. Park safe - avoid quiet streets, park where it is well lit.
- 7. Keep your keys safe.

No Interest Loan Scheme

Have you lived in the local Gosford Area for at least 3 months? Are you on a low income? If so you maybe eligible for a No Interest Loan.

The amount you can borrow will vary, depending on your income & your capacity to make repayments. The maximum is \$800 for entertainment items such as TVs/Stereos, & up to \$1,200 for essential items like white goods/furniture. NILS[®] may also be provided to meet other essential needs like health aids, car registration or education costs. NILS[®] is not for emergency relief, bond or rent money, living expenses or debt repayment. The limit for people on Newstart/Youth Allowance is between \$600 - \$800, to ensure we don't place anyone in financial hardship. The repayment period is usually around 12 to 18 months. "Caring for Kariong"

Skin Cancer

Two in three Australians will be diagnosed with skin cancer by the time they are 70.

The sooner a skin cancer is identified and treated, the better your chance of avoiding surgery or, in the case of a serious melanoma or other skin cancer, potential disfigurement or even death.

Become familiar with the look of your skin, so you pick up any changes that might suggest a skin cancer. Look for:

- any crusty, non-healing sores
- small lumps that are red, pale or pearly in colour
- new spots, freckles or any moles changing in colour, thickness or shape over a period of weeks to months (especially those dark brown to black, red or blue-black in colour).

If you notice any changes make an appointment with your regular GP by phoning 4340 4444. Your doctor may perform a biopsy (remove a small sample of tissue for examination under a microscope) or refer you to a specialist if he/she suspects a skin cancer.

Also at Kariong Medical Centre we have our GP, Dr Dionne Bolla who specialises in skin cancer, she is available most Tuesdays and Thursdays. Most importantly protection from the sun is the best prevention. This includes;

Slip on some sun-protective clothing – that covers as much skin as possible

Slop on broad spectrum, water resistant SPF30+ sunscreen. Put it on 20 minutes before you go outdoors and every two hours afterwards. Sunscreen should never be used to extend the time you spend in the sun.

Slap on a hat – that protects your face, head, neck and ears

Seek shade

Slide on some sunglasses – make sure they meet Australian Standards

Hello from the desk of the Standpipe

Well we are another month closer to Christmas, which means warmer weather and dryer conditions. So far we have been lucky in our neck of the woods with only minor flare ups around the area. I hope by now most of you have heeded the warning to prepare your home for the hotter,

dryer months ahead!

With that thought in mind – Have you thought about your feather and fur friends? Make sure you include their safety and requirements when completing your Bush Fire Plan.

Our Open Day on the 28th September was a great success. The red truck received an extra spit and polish for the day and didn't disappoint the little ones of Kariong that enjoyed having a sit in the passenger seat. Thanks to all the Crew on duty for showing our community around the station, demonstrating some of the equipment we use, answering any questions and cooking a great BBQ.

As I mentioned in last month's Standpipe, we visited the Kariong Child Care Centre in Langford Drive. The children's eyes lit up when they saw the truck pull into their car park. We had a little chat with them about fire safety in the home and out in the bush. We played a couple of games and they asked some very important questions. Then it was out to the truck to have a look around. The garden had a good soaking with all of the children having a go at the hose. The visit ended with a climb up into the truck and out the other side. Even the teachers had a go!

Since the last Standpipe our Brigade has been given the privilege of having a second truck in the Station. We now have Kariong 1A and Kariong 1B. This will enhance the ability of the Brigade to protect the Community as best as we can. One of our trucks with a full Crew on board, was deployed in a Strike Force Team, for 12 hours, to the Lower Hunter Rural Fire Service to assist their Crews with the recent Salt Ash, Fingal Bay and Heatherbrae fires.

There have been a few TOBAN (Total Fire Ban) days lately and no doubt there are going to be a lot more before this year ends and we are into April 2014. A TOBAN is usually announced around 5:00pm, and comes into effect at midnight that night for 24 hours. It can be extended. During this time no fires are permitted except for a gas or electric BBQ, which must be in the control of an adult and have a water supply readily available. All permits are suspended until the TOBAN is lifted. To find out more – www.rfs.nsw.gov.au. Until next month Stay Safe and Firewise.
