

'Power & Mysteries of Tai Chi'

(from Australian Academy of Tai Chi's Term 3 Newsletter)

Beginners in Tai Chi and Qigong usually have no idea of just how much is in store for them. The slow, graceful movements of Tai Chi are so deceptive that most people see it as just a gentle exercise art. In their wildest dreams, they cannot imagine the vast universe hidden within the art. In its entirety. Tai Chi is not only a model for exploring the wide spectrum of life's energies and dynamics; it is ideal for exploring all aspects of our human makeup: the physical, mental, emotional, energetic, and spiritual. It cannot be predicted from observation—it must be experienced. Something magical happens when the movements are performed harmoniously; however because of its many layers and depth, many do not have the patience and perseverance to stay with it until experiencing its magic.

The experience is analogous to learning to ride a bicycle. It only works when it's moving; but initially, you don't know that. If you are familiar with other wheels, you might guess that "this thing's meant to roll", but it falls over when unsupported. You struggle to keep it upright, fighting the pull of gravity, but after a number of painful falls, you find yourself anticipating the next one. As your attention becomes fixed on resisting all that can go wrong, you find it difficult to do the one thing you need to do to succeed: *relax* into the centre of your body. Surrender totally to the state of relaxation, and suddenly you're riding!

The majority of people who seek to master Tai Chi usually have to backtrack in their studies; normally first learning the solo form postures and then later seeking out the fundamental principles and 'hidden' aspects for example: soong (relaxed alertness), diaphragmatic breathing, focussing the mind-intent, and sinking the *Chi* into the *Tan Tien* to name a few. Aside from bringing many health benefits, conscientious practise imparts calmness and hidden wisdom that can transform the individual in unexpected ways...

Watch Out - Snakes about !!



We have had reports of increased snake activity in the recent weeks with the warmer weather fast approaching. Please be vigilant with your property and keep a close eye on children and pets. Remove any piles of rubble, wood, roof sheeting or leaf clippings where snakes can shelter. If you believe your pet has been bitten by a snake please take them to the nearest veterinary clinic.

Hello from the desk of the **Standpipe**

Our calls from August 22 until present are still not available. Hopefully next month I will be able to report to you the statistics. Just a couple more **Bush Fire MYTHS** I would like to share with you:



Myth: Fire travels slower up hill!

Fact: Fires will move faster up a hill and slower down a hill. The speed of a fire will double with every 10 degree increase in slope. For example on a 20 degree slope, bush fire speed is four times faster than on flat ground.

Myth: Standing on my roof and hosing it down with water will help! Fact: During a bush fire more injuries normally occur from people falling off roofs than from burns! Filling your gutters with water and hosing down your roof will help with spot fires due to ember attack, but hosing should be done from the ground or off a ladder.

Fire Danger Ratings: The Fire Danger Rating gives you an indication of the consequences of a fire, if a fire was to start. The rating is based on predicted conditions such as temperature, humidity, wind and dryness of the landscape. It tells you how a bush fire may act, what impacts there might be on the community if a bush fire were to start and when to implement your Bush Fire Survival Plan. There are thousands of the Fire Danger Signs throughout Australia, one being on the Central Coast Highway at Kariong.

FIRE DANGER RATING	WHAT YOU SHOULD DO					
CATASTROPHIC	For your survival, leaving early is only option. Leave bush fire prone areas the night before or early in the day – do not just wait and see what happens. Homes are not designed to withstand fires in catastrophic conditions so you should leave early.					
EXTREME	Leaving early is the safest option for your survival. Only consider staying if you are well prepared and can actively defend your specially designed, constructed or modified home.					
SEVERE	Well prepared homes that are actively defended can provide safety – but only stay if you are physically and mentally prepared to defend in these conditions.					
VERY HIGH	Review your Bush Fire Survival Plan with your family. Keep					
HIGH	yourself informed and monitor conditions.					
LOW MODERATE	Be ready to act if necessary.

Each week I have the privilege of teaching scripture at Kariong Public School, to the year 6 students. I love their enthusiasm, excitement

and zest for life. Each week, as part of my lesson, I ask them questions about the future and their plans for their lives. I am amazed at times by their answers. One of my students is convinced he is going to play for Manchester United. I was thinking about that as I left my students, and I realised how long it has been since I was in year 6, and how long it has been since I dreamed dreams as big as that.

I was later reminded of this as I was reading through Psalm 90, which talks about numbering our days. We all have a limited time here on earth, probably averaging out at around 70 years (referred to as three score years and ten in the Bible), and most of us don't give a lot of thought as to how we pass those days, or what comes next. We get caught in the daily grind of work and meeting our responsibilities and, before we know it, years have passed and we might be wondering whether anything we have done really matters in the big scheme of things.

One way to ensure that you try to make the most of each day, is to number your days. If the average life is 70 years, then we can break that down to 25,567 days. At 35, you have used half of those days! A bit scary isn't it? Have you ever considered what comes when we reach the end of our days? One certainty in this life is that this life will end. But the Bible tells us death is not the end.


