It's hard to believe we are now into the final term of the year!!



<u>CCTV cameras for Kariong</u>: installation now completed for the two shopping centre car parks, the skate park and The Hill Youth Centre car park.

Mt Penang Highway Precinct and the Langford Drive / Woy Woy Road intersection: no action on these two matters at present.

<u>At a recent meeting with the Police</u> they brought to our attention that there is some rise in opportunistic crime causing some concern to them, for example <u>'Steal from Person'</u> occurring Monday through Thursday, and on Sundays from business/shopping areas, with mainly female victims, and theft of communication devices.

Also <u>'Steal from Dwelling'</u> mostly occurring on Saturdays and Sundays between noon and 4.00pm, through open garage doors, and open windows and doors. With summer coming on the Police are worried this will increase with people leaving their homes open during the warmer weather.

And don't forget a book is held at the Kariong Neighbourhood Centre, where any local resident can document any particular issue that concerns them in relation to Kariong. That way the Progress Association can take up the matter with the relevant people, and hopefully resolve problems before they become major concerns within the community.

G'Day folks,

Back again with more news from the Kariong fire shed. Well, warmer days have finally arrived and with that I want to raise a bushfire survival issue with you.

You've no doubt heard on the telly, papers and radio about filling out a **Bushfire Survival Plan** (BSP) and for those who have, good onya. For those who haven't, the fire services are advising you to get onto it and get it sorted because as I've mentioned in past issues, no one can predict the weather to 100% but the indicators are that we may be in for a hot summer and along with that the higher risk of fire activity.

In your BSP you'll find info on what to do if you are to leave early or stay and defend but the matter I want to raise with you is what if it's too late to leave; and that's covered in the BSP too. I'm focusing in this instance, the village of Kariong and its' **Neighbourhood Safer Place**. Ask yourself this question: Do I know where it is in Kariong? I'm betting a few of you don't and that's the point of the exercise.

Kariong residents Place of Last Resort or Neighbourhood Safer Place is the oval area adjacent to the café in the Mt Penang Parklands precinct.

This is the place you go to that will provide some protection away from the immediate threat of a bush fire. It is a short-term place only and is NOT an Evacuation Centre, Fire Refuge or Welfare Centre. You need to remember that there may not be food, water and toilet facilities or emergency service personnel present so you still need to be prepared.

Folks, let's be very clear. I'm not trying to frighten anyone or overstate the issue, it's just fact and common sense, so please do your local Firies a huge favour and get onto this ASAP.

Lastly, Kariong Rural Fire Brigade will be turning 70 next year and I'm shouting out to any Kariong-ite who may have some brigade history to contact us. Doesn't matter what it is just give us a bell on 0419 838 385 or 0428 401 694 or email us on;

Sport is a big part of Australian life and plays a huge part in our national identity. We're avid followers of 'footy', which covers everything from rugby union to Australian AFL. We turn out in our thousands to watch the Grand Final, the State of Origin, the World Cup, the cricket at the MCG, the Grand Slam tennis and the Australian Masters. We are fiercely proud of Australia's reputation as a nation of sporting achievers. And so we should be.

Watching and playing sport is a great way for families and communities to come together. But thanks to the rise of the sports betting, professional sport is now saturated with gambling ads. Promotions for gambling appear in stadiums and during broadcasts of matches on electronic banners; in commercials before and after matches, during breaks in play; and as team sponsorship on Guernseys and team banners. It's now impossible to watch a major sporting event without being urged to bet.

Gambling too, is a part of Australian culture and many Australians enjoy a punt. But gambling has a dangerous side. Problem gambling destroys lives and it is on the rise. The saturation of advertising normalises gambling and people are coming to associate gambling as integral part of sport. Rather than talking about their favourite team, people are now talking about the odds of that team winning. Young men in particular are being primed to start their gambling careers early.


