

The Association would like to thank Mrs Yvonne Hart for her continued hard work with the Bookings for the Kariong Hall and the Kariong Tennis Courts. Yvonne gives much time and effort to help Community hirers whilst ensuring both venues are well maintained.

Some of the projects currently on the Progress Assoc agenda: **Traffic lights** at the intersection of Woy Woy Road and Langford Drive Progress Assoc working in association with the Intersection Action Committee. This has allowed over 1300 signatures to be presented as a petition to Councillor Craig Doyle and our parliamentarian Chris Holstein. We understand that Gosford City Council will prepare the initial report.

Graffiti removal in Kariong is a project we are supporting and working with the Attorney General's Dept. together with the Gosford City Council and local organisations to ensure this practice is not part of our community. Subject to weather conditions the exterior of the Scout Hall should be refurbished by the time you read this article.

Curringa Road traffic congestion continues to be contentious due to the width of this main traffic artery. Whilst the physical aspects of this are challenging we will continue to work with Gosford City Council on ways to enhance traffic flow.

Community safety is paramount for any suburb, not least Kariong, and the Kariong Progress Association therefore totally support our Neighbourhood Watch/Eye Watch team who are ably strengthened by the Gosford Police Unit. It was also pleasing to be advised of the appointment of a new permanent commander in Superintendent Daniel Sullivan who has an impressive CV in policing. This year Progress will be assisting with some new youth functions which will expand facilities and entertainment for Kariong teenagers.

Councillor attendance at our monthly meetings over the past year has been anchored by Councillor Vicki Scott and we have acknowledged her support during this time. We also look forward to her continuing participation along with, we hope, some of the new Councillors who were recently elected to Gosford City Council.

The Kariong Rural Fire Service, with our support, held an open day and seminar on Saturday 22^{nd} September so you will, we trust, have taken the opportunity to attend. This was a new expanded function and the speakers included supporting units of the Brigade plus representatives of National Parks. An important and timely event for Kariong at this time of the year!

"Caring for Kariong"

Skin Cancer

Two in three Australians will be diagnosed with skin cancer by the time they are 70.

The sooner a skin cancer is identified and treated, the better your chance of avoiding surgery or, in the case of a serious melanoma or other skin cancer, potential disfigurement or even death.

Become familiar with the look of your skin, so you pick up any changes that might suggest a skin cancer. Look for:

- any crusty, non-healing sores
- small lumps that are red, pale or pearly in colour
- new spots, freckles or any moles changing in colour, thickness or shape over a period of weeks to months (especially those dark brown to black, red or blue-black in colour).

If you notice any changes make an appointment with your regular GP by phoning 4340 4444. Your doctor may perform a biopsy (remove a small sample of tissue for examination under a microscope) or refer you to a specialist if he/she suspects a skin cancer. Also at Kariong Medical Centre we have our GP, Dr Dionne Bolla who specialises in skin cancer, she is available most Tuesday and Thursdays. Most importantly protection from the sun is the best prevention. This includes;

- Slip on some sun-protective clothing that covers as much skin as possible
- **Slop** on broad spectrum, water resistant SPF30+ sunscreen. Put it on 20 minutes before you go outdoors and every two hours afterwards. Sunscreen should never be used to extend the time you spend in the sun.
- Slap on a hat that protects your face, head, neck and ears
- Seek shade
- **Slide** on some sunglasses make sure they meet Australian Standards



Already we've seen hazard reductions go in around Mangrove dam area, Wendourie village area as well as a couple of bushfires so I'm thinking that it could be an interesting summer. Folks I've got to say this again, if you're living in the district, chances are you are surrounded or have close by, bushland. Please do your local fire fighters a huge favour and get yourself organised in terms of preparing your home & property in case you are threatened by bushfire. It is so simple, get tidied up around the yard, clear your roof and gutters of leaf litter, get any stacked timber away from the house, check your trusty old garden hose for serviceability. Yes it may be a days work for you but it will pay off in the long run if we have a problem near you. If you've got any questions then get in contact with your local fire authority. The Emergency Operations Centre on Woy Woy Road is open during business hours on 4340 2811. Give them a call if you're not sure on what you can do to best protect yourself and they'll steer you in the right direction. On Saturday 22nd September Kariong RFB had its Open Day along with a public forum and meeting. The Open Day was a great success for us with lots of families coming through the station having a look around, climbing through the trucks, sitting in on one of Miss Jacquie (Clason) home safety talks and watching the guys go through their paces in a smoke filled room with their breathing apparatus. There was lots of information available on all sorts of issues relating to the RFS's Firewise and Prepare Act Survive program as well as some fun stuff for the kids. Interestingly enough, a few people came up to me making comment on a few things that I should touch on in this article so here goes. The first issue was mentioned by a local chap who regularly drives the F3 to and from work. He constantly sees occupants of cars throwing out their lit cigarette butts which he says that you can see quite clearly sparking up when they hit the ground. Folks, not only is this silly it's quite irresponsible because all you need is a little breeze and some dry grass and you've got yourself a fire. Not to mention the fine that you'll cop if you're identified as the culprit. As far as I know every car has an ash tray, please use it and save the hassle. 
