

The Kariong Neighbourhood Centre hosted another very successful community forum on Thursday September 18th with members of the Kariong community and local service providers in attendance.

Our Guest speakers were **Dianne Tsotras** from **Sunnyfield Disability Services** at Mt Penang who talked in depth of the services that Sunnyfield provides to it's clients and the future plans for the service. We then heard from **Peter Watson** from **Police Link** who gave us information on what the services were under the NSW Police Force, i.e. 000 Emergency, Police Assistance Line (PAL) and Crime Stoppers – Peter explained what these services were and the appropriate use of the numbers. Peter also explained about Youth Conferencing which is a valuable service provided to Youth through Juvenile Justice and assists troubled youth who are in legal trouble to be supported through the community rather than be sent to a correctional facility. We have some pamphlets and information at the Centre with the Police Link information for anyone who would like a copy.

Anne Stewart, Manager of Fair Trading Gosford talked to us about the workshops that Fair Trading was now running through local Neighbourhood and Community Centres on various topics – you will find more in depth information in a separate Ad in this Connection and we encourage anyone interested in attending to register your interest with the Centre using the contact details below. KARIONG MEDICAL CENTRE NEWS

Spring is here and this brings with it warmer weather. This is a great time of year to start thinking about our health. Moving into the warmer months we generally become more active and start eating lighter and spending more time outdoors.

Did you know that Kariong Medical Centre offers a weight loss clinic to mentor people through weight loss. This is a nurse run clinic that is monitored by your Doctor.

The Healthy Kids Check for children aged 4 is now a mandatory requirement for Centrelink payments. Please call us to make an appointment and advise that the appointment is for the Healthy Kids Check so the appropriate amount of time is allowed for this service. Please bring your Blue book to update immunisation at the time of appointment, as this is your proof of immunisation for Centrelink.

If you are aged between 45-49 years of age, you are invited to make an appointment for a Health Check. This is a good prevention tool and the cost is covered by Medicare.

We also offer Health Checks for people who are over 75 years and still living in their own homes. The over 75 year old Health Care Assessments are designed to keep people in their own homes by putting them in touch with local services. These checks require an appointment with one of our practice nurses and your Doctor. The comprehensive assessment takes about 45mins and is billed through Medicare. This is a worthwhile and proactive service offered at Kariong Medical Centre.



Hello from the Desk of the

Standpipe

Welcome to the "Standpipe" your local Brigade's monthly article in the Kariong Connection.

Our statistics for the month of September are unavailable at this time. They will be included in next month's Standpipe.



The bushfire season commenced on October 1. An "above normal" bush fire season is expected for much of NSW, according to the latest outlook from the Bushfire & Natural Hazards Cooperative Research Centre which was published on Sept 6, 2014. Getting ready for the bush fire season could be easier than you think. Even the little things can make a difference during a bush fire.

Our top tips are:

- Prepare or revisit your Bush Fire Survival Plan
- Clear leaves, sticks and other things that could burn from your gutters.
- Prune shrubs and trees so they are not overhanging the home.
- * Rake up leaves and litter from your property
- * Move firewood away from your home
- * Keep lawns mowed and gardens well maintained
- Keep things that can burn like flammable liquids in an enclosed are and not out in the open
- Make sure your hose is in good condition and will reach all corners of your property
- If you have a water tank, swimming pool etc. you can get a SWS (static water supply) sign from your Brigade so firefighters know there is another water source on the property. Call 4340 2911 to arrange to get one.
- Enclose underfloor areas and make sure there are no gaps or broken tiles in the roof – they can let in burning embers.

It doesn't take long, but these simple steps can make all the difference. If you have a mobile device such as an iPhone, iPad, Android, tablet or smart phone, current fire information is available in a number of ways. – * Fires Near Me NSW – Mobile App (Provides fire information on bush fire incidents in NSW), * Fires Near Me – Mobile App (Provides fire information from participating Australian and New Zealand fire agencies), * MyFirePlan – Bush Fire Survival Plan App (A mobile and smartphone version of the Bush Fire Survival Plan), *Emergency+Smartphone App (A mobile and smartphone app to help you identify your location when calling Triple Zero). NSW RFS encourages you to not rely solely on these applications and services.

Hazard Reductions are happening in and around our area. There was a largish one conducted at the Mangrove Creek Catchment Area late last month.




