Difficulty paying bills?

The Energy & Water Ombudsman NSW (EWON) provides the following information to help people experiencing difficulties with their energy bills.

Sometimes you may face financial hardship meaning you're unable to pay all of your bills on time. If you continue to miss your energy bill payments, you risk being disconnected by your provider.

Energy and water providers have programs that can help you stay connected. All electricity and gas providers in NSW are required to offer a minimum of two payments plans in any 12 month period. They are also required to have hardship programs in place for longer term help with paying energy bills.

If your bill is overdue or you receive a reminder notice, you should contact your provider straight away. If your provider is not able to work with you to offer an affordable payment plan, you can contact EWON for advice or to make a complaint.

Your options

If you're struggling to pay your energy bills you can: ask for extra time to pay ask for a formal payment plan or ask to be assessed for your provider's hardship program.

A payment plan is a formal payment arrangement between you and your provider. Your provider will work with you to create a suitable payment plan based on:

- your capacity to pay
- your energy usage
- the amount owing on your account.

What other help is available?

The NSW Government offers energy rebates to eligible customers. For more information contact your provider, call the Energy Info Line on 1300 136 888 or visit resourcesandenergy.nsw.gov.au.

Energy Accounts Payment Assistance (EAPA) vouchers are available to help pay a current electricity or gas bill. These provide assistance in a crisis or emergency situation and are distributed by community organisations.




Books up for discussion next month are **Sweetsmoke** by David Fuller. *The*American Civil War is in full flame, and tobacco plantation slave Cassius

Poker machines are deeply etched into the fabric of life in NSW as they've been around for almost 60 years. After a hard day's work people gravitate to their local to unwind and socialise with their mates, and inevitably wander off to the machines to have a slap or a punt.

Australia is unusual among other countries in that we allow poker machines in non-gaming venues like pubs and clubs, instead of limiting them to casinos, race tracks, gambling halls, and the like.

We are the world's biggest gamblers, losing more money per capita than anyone in the world. We have more poker machines per person than any country on earth. For example figures released by the Department of Liquor and Gaming's: Gaming Machine Report by Local Government Area (LGA) for the Period 1 June 2017 to 30 November 2017 showed a profit of \$108,751,381.24 (one hundred eight million, seven hundred fifty-one thousand, three hundred eighty-one and twenty-four cents) from 4,033 gaming machines in 40 clubs on the Central Coast as well as \$26.5 million in profits from 626 poker machines in 29 hotels on the Central Coast.

In an effort to reduce growing problem gambling hot spots across the state, the NSW government will cap the number of machines in pubs and clubs in areas with the highest levels of problem gambling. Some of the current local government area hotspots for gaming machines in hotels and clubs include Blacktown, Canterbury-Bankstown, Cumberland, Fairfield, Sydney's inner west, Sydney City and the Central Coast.

G'Day folks.

I'm back with some more news from Kariong Rural Fire Brigade for this month.

Well, at the time of writing, Mother Nature in her infinite wisdom has made Autumn a very fickle time indeed. The "official" fire season finished on the 31st of March and now we're into April a massive fire has taken hold south-west of Sydney around the Holdsworthy area burning out many hectares of bushland as well as threatening homes. Kariong brigade along with several local Coast brigades were sent to the area as part of a strike team to assist in operations there. And there-in lies the lesson folks. That is, never be complacent with bushfire safety because fire knows no boundaries between seasons and always be aware of what's going on around you and if you see suspicious activity around bushland, report it.

Operationally speaking, Kariong had 34 calls for the month of March. Topping the list once again was 18 motor vehicle accidents so the message is still the same folks and that's take care, drive to the conditions, don't drink & drive, don't be under the influence of drugs & drive and stay off the mobile. As the Police say ... "You can stop it or cop it"

At this point I'd like to acknowledge the efforts of two Kariong members who, over the past four months have done a tremendous amount of work both on paper and pounding the pavement in preparing and processing the Brigades constitution. Both Chris Tierney (Secretary) and Nita Hughes (Treasurer) have made an outstanding contribution to getting this monumental process completed. This is not a small job by any means and both these members have gone to great lengths to have all the I's dotted and T's crossed and on behalf of the membership, THANK YOU.

Finally folks, the station is open Wednesday nights from 7.30 pm and Saturday mornings from 8.00 am. We're in Dandaloo Street and if you've ever thought about joining the service come up and



have a chat with us. We'd be more than happy to see you.

That's it for now. Remember, stay safe and be Firewise.
