

Electricity and gas providers offer customer assistance programs to help customers stay on top of their energy bills

In New South Wales, electricity and gas retailers are required to operate a customer assistance program. Each retailer may have slightly different eligibility criteria.

When a customer is part of an assistance program they are protected from disconnection and have access to tailored payment arrangements to help them manage their account. There may be other incentives the retailer offers customers for making regular payments such as waiving fees or making co-payments.

If you are struggling with your energy bills, ask your retailer if you are eligible for their customer assistance program. See EWON's website for more information about what help is available including Energy Account Payment Assistance (EAPA), rebates and financial counselling.

Do you know someone who is affected by problem gambling?

People who gamble heavily are often stigmatised and feel great shame so unfortunately they don't seek help until they reach a crisis.

Typically, people who gamble to problematic levels feel incredibly guilty because of the debts they have accumulated, because of the lies they told to partners, friends and family and because they keep going back to gamble. And they worse they feel about themselves the more they will gamble.

Harm can be far-reaching, causing significant damage to individuals, families and communities. Some of the effects of problem gambling include financial loss or bankruptcy, relationship breakdowns, or health problems such as depression, anxiety, ulcers, high blood pressure, or even suicidal thoughts.

If you think someone may be struggling with gambling, either directly or as the result of their relationship with a problem gambler, take them aside for a cuppa and let them know that help is available

As we start each new school year, there is a sense of excitement about how each student will grow their knowledge as the year progresses. I feel privileged to go on this journey with our citizens of the future and look forward to sharing, both our school's stories and education news/research in general, with the community throughout the year. This year we have students travelling to Japan in April, the Snow in August and Year 10 to Queensland to celebrate the conclusion of their junior schooling. This complements a wide range of other co-curricula opportunities and participation in many different sporting events. I have always been a firm believer of the philosophy of the benefits of students engaging with many different and diverse activities, rather than specialising too young, as it is the different perspectives and mindsets that you can then call upon to truly bring something creative and successful to any endeavour. The careers of the future are seeking such unconstrained thinkers and we design our curriculum to develop this potential.

As your child has moved to a higher grade, you may be thinking of the routines that need to be established to assist learning. I would suggest that "being organised" is an important skill to consider. Having a diary and using it daily, recording homework, putting in reminders for that homework prior to its due date, knowing the lessons being taught the next day and then packing for those class requirements the night before are all simple tips that will make a difference in your child's capacity to maximise their learning. "Being organised" is telling the brain to get ready for learning and helps make it a habit of mind.

Please don't hesitate to contact the school if you have any questions/suggestions/ideas about your child's learning.



G'Day everyone.

I'm back for a whole new year with news from Kariong Rural Fire Brigade. I sincerely hope you all had a great Christmas & New Year and are ready for the year ahead.

First & foremost on my mind right now is road safety. Unless you've been out of the country this past few months, NSW road statistics are horrendous which has the Police dismayed, frustrated not to mention annoyed. They've all but begged the motoring public to take care, be aware, don't drive drunk, don't drive drugged, don't use your mobile whilst driving and drive to the conditions. Sadly, there were quite a few who didn't heed the message and payed the ultimate price. Folks, I say this without reservation that it is all up to the driver when behind the wheel. I spent about four years speaking at local Traffic Offenders program nights and the statistics are mind boggling. For example, the program lasted eight weeks and at the start of each program, without fail, there were between 35 and 40 participants and the offenses were all the same every time. Speeding, DUI even 'loss of traction' Doing burn-outs in other words. Just about each participant explained themselves by saying...." I thought I'd be right" Obviously they weren't. Unfortunately, these days with everyone "time poor", drivers are in the "here & now" and anything in between doesn't exist and in between the "here" and "now" are where the problems start. I've observed inattentive & sloppy drivers with only one intention on their mind and that is to get from point A to point B in the shortest possible time and not considering anything or anyone else on the road. They are out there trust me. From a firefighter's perspective the all too often occurrence of "MVA Persons Trapped" coming across the radio is a gut-tightening experience let me tell you because you know it may not end well. So please, in this case don't just do it for your poor humble firefighter but for everyone who uses the road, drive safely, drive to the conditions and drive to survive.

Operationally speaking, the brigade has had an average Christmas and New Year period as far a fire activity is concerned with a few warm days here and there but thankfully no major incidents.

OK folks, that's it for now. Remember, drive to the conditions and be Firewise. Till next time.
