The Council is going to use the old Wyong Council model of the Council managing the Hall itself. Any individual or group wanting to hire the Hall would do so via the Council direct, and of course the money collected would go straight into the Council coffers.

### Kariong Community Hall

Central Coast council has advised the Kariong Neighbourhood Centre that, originally it was planned to undertake an Expression of Interest for ongoing management of Kariong Community Hall, however it was decided to maintain the bookings in house under Council's booking system for community facilities in line with the management of community facilities in the former-Wyong Shire area.

The fees and charges will be the same for the northern community facilities and are levied on a simple hourly rate basis making them easy to understand and administer. Not-for-profit groups receive a substantial discount on the fees.

The hall fees are determined by hall size. Council's booking officer will be reviewing the hall soon and will be able to confirm the pricing structure shortly after. If the hall is assessed as the largest size, the fees would be as follows:

### Casual hire \$35/hour Permanent booking hire \$28/hour Not-for-profit hire \$10/hour

Council will open the hall up for both casual and permanent bookings and looks forward to working with the community to ensure this asset is maintained and available for a wide variety of community groups and private users. Council is inviting groups interested in making long-term bookings to register their interest by emailing Council at <u>ask@centralcoast.nsw.gov.au</u> so they can notify them when Council is ready to commence taking bookings.

It is anticipated the hall will open again shortly.

### More Music Opportunities at Kariong Mountains High School

Our school was designed to provide learning opportunities in the areas of bioscience and technology (ahead of its time in catering for learning in STEM), but we have always adhered to the premise of 21st century learners needing expertise in STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts and Mathematics).

I am excited to share with you another step forward in our capacity to deliver outstanding programs at Kariong Mountains High School. At the time of writing, we are the only school on the coast able to deliver the Music Industry Certificate III course - in fact, we are writing the course on behalf of the RTO (another example of the calibre of teacher at our school). This course is for students who want to work behind the scenes, in sound and mixing production. It's also a great course for students who want to be on stage as they have a greater capacity to manage much of the production side of performing, themselves.

Yet, there is still more. We have begun a partnership with 'The Grove Music Studio' and hence a pathway for students to further their studies in sound production, mixing and recording. Our students will have access to the studio to produce an end of course professional EP. What an opportunity and when considered with the in-school tutoring by tutors from 'Creative Rush', busking and performing experiences in which our students regularly engage, it all adds up to authentic, relevant learning at its best.

Kariong Eco Garden and Kariong Progress Association representatives met with Jane Smith, the new Mayor of Central Coast Council (on Sunday 8/10/17) to show her the plan for removal of many mature trees in the process of lining up Dandaloo Street with Langford Drive, for the new roundabout in Woy Woy Road.



We are not opposed to the roundabout, as long as we get a pedestrian crossing with lights (like Brisbane Water Drive, Point Clare) on busy Woy Woy Road, but we question why the planners didn't consider how they could minimize tree loss in the design.

We are seeking support from council staff and councilors to modify the angle of the 'new' Dandaloo Street, a minor road compared to Woy Woy Road, but important to the residents, Kariong Rural Fire Service, Great Beginnings Childcare Centre, Kariong Hall\*, Arts Barn and the Eco Garden volunteers and visitors.

We believe that the 'new' Dandaloo Street can be built wholly on the northern side of the large angophora, and the two old scribbly gums, on the edge of the car park, leaving them to provide shade and habitat. These trees could be as old as the Hall, which was built in 1957 - 60 years ago.

A group of supporters gathered under these trees on Monday 9/10/17 to call on the new Central Coast Council to value urban trees for their shade, habitat, oxygenmaking and the way they create cool green spaces, helping counter the effects of climate change. Federal Member Lucy Wicks gave her apologies that she could not meet the group on site at that time, as did Deputy Mayor Chris Holstein, Councilors Louise Greenaway and Jilly Pillon. Talks with Council are continuing and there is hope that the second council meeting (23/10/17) will have Trees on the Agenda.



These trees are just some of many facing threats across, not only our local government area, but across the state of NSW. Communities are having to protect green spaces in many places. Mt Penang Parklands is another case in point. The scribbly gum community, many with amazing nesting hollows, are heritage listed. Our community will need to remain vigilant to make sure they are not lost to inappropriate development. Kariong Eco Garden, along with other locals, lodged a submission on the DA on 25 September. # WHAT'S ON ••• At Kariong Library


System upgrades have been carried out over the past few weeks giving us one of the largest catalogues in the State; twice as much stock available and access with one library card across the Central Coast.




Spend a fun, creative morning with your pre-school children. **Storytime** is held every Tuesday morning at 10.30am and is an exciting programme to encourage a love of reading.

I'm back with some more news from Kariong Rural Fire Brigade.

October saw some welcome rain to the district with some falls that one could say, "settled the dust" but not enough to declare that we're out of the woods in terms of fire danger. If you follow the weather people, even they're struggling to get a handle on the situation so the message is folks, don't let your guard down and keep vigilant.

During the end of September and into October saw brigades including Kariong going up into the Hunter, Lake Macquarie and surrounding districts assisting in firefighting duties there. Great efforts by all teams saw fires contained and extinguished. Another two fires closer to home saw crews attending around the back of The Tip down Woy Woy as well as Koolewong escarpment. Again, crews did a wonderful job in difficult conditions getting these ones sorted as they had the potential to be real problems.

Folks, I want to talk to you about joining the New South Wales Rural Fire Service. Kariong is always looking for new members who are keen on doing their bit in helping to protect people, properties and the environment. The training is self-paced and free. Uniforms and personal protective gear is provided. Once you pass your basic course you can branch out into different areas such as Village & Advanced firefighting, Breathing Apparatus, Heavy Vehicle driving, Remote Area Firefighting Teams, Communications, Air Base Operations and list goes on. Have a think about it and if you think this is for you then come up to the Dandaloo Street fire station any Wednesday night after 7.30pm or Saturday morning after 8am and have a chat with us.

Another matter that I want to raise is that Kariong is doing some refurb work in the station. We need to resurface our training room floor with a resilient material because our old lino is slowly crumbling. Just putting it out there to anyone who reads this column if they know of a supplier or who is a supplier of flooring material who may be able to help us getting this project sorted, then give us a call. Call 0450 169948 any time if you can give us a hand. Lastly, from all the Brigade have a safe and wonderful Christmas & New Year.
