Mt Penang Parklands Development Application



RESPONSIBLE GAMBLING AWARENESS WEEK falls on 23-29 October this year to bring it in line with Victoria, Tasmania, Western Australia and the ACT.

Responsible Gambling Awareness Week (RGAW) is an annual event that raises community awareness about the importance of gambling responsibly.

Gambling responsibly means being able to exercise control over your gambling activities and not letting it impact on other areas of your life. Remember these tips on Responsible Gambling Practices:

- Set strict limits on how much time you spend it's easy to lose track of time when you're gambling. Set a time limit or alarm, and when time's up quit! Odds are that the more time you spend gambling, the more money you will lose.
- Set strict limits for how much money you spend on gambling — always remember you're putting your money at risk. Decide how much you can afford to lose before you go to play. When it's gone leave!
- Don't risk what you can't afford to lose never gamble with money you need for other things. Gamble within your weekly entertainment budget, not with your phone bill, grocery or rent budget.
- Gambling should not be considered as an easy way of making money — the odds are not in your favour; in the long run the house always wins. Any gambling activity should be viewed as entertainment. Consider your losses as a cost of that entertainment.
- Don't ever chase your losses and try to recover them if you lose — chasing your losses will usually just lead to bigger and bigger losses.
- Don't gamble when you're depressed or upset Decision-making can be more difficult when you're stressed or emotionally upset. Make sure you only gamble when you're feeling clear headed.

To parents and students alike, I would like to remind you that a HSC result, a lifetime destination does not make. It is the start of the journey and it will be the young person's choices throughout their life that determines where they go and what they do.

Social Media Information

Our students have to navigate the world of relationships and emotions in a far different way to years gone by. I learnt a new acronym just recently – "FOMO" – the fear of missing out. So much is posted on social media that apparently more of our youth are now subject to anxiety relating to opting out, missing an event and just taking some time for themselves. Sometimes, as a community, trying to support our children can be complicated because we aren't aware of the full range of pressures to which they are subjected.

Another online concern is, of course, the issue relating to fake accounts that are set up in the child's name for the purpose of mischief or harm. In schools, we teach students to be cyber safe, but our experience is that they can still be too trusting and allow others access to their online presence.

Here's some more news from the Dandaloo Street fire station for this month.

Folks, I normally go into some monthly brigade stats as a lead-off into this column however, I feel it necessary to discuss other matters of greater importance with you. My intention is not to alarm anyone but it is my intention to prepare everyone that if things get nasty we'll at least be ready for it.

As I mentioned last issue that the dry spell continues and could possibly run well into October which is the start of the Bushfire Danger Period from October 1st. The NSWRFS and other agencies have upped the ante with hazard reduction burns targeted at reducing fuel loads in strategic areas before the real heat starts as we get into summer. I've said this to you many times before and I'm going to do it now and that is be prepared for this fire season. By being prepared I mean do all your "around the house" stuff like clearing gutters, decluttering the yard and trimming back over-hung branches. Checking your garden hose is in good order and at least is long enough to go half-way around the house. This is especially important for those of you living on the bushland interface in Kariong. Get your Bushfire Survival Plan sorted or review last year's one and know what to do and where to go if the worst happens. For those who don't know, Mt Penang Parklands is Kariong's refuge area in a large bushfire. This area is a refuge only and does not necessarily mean there will be food and water available and that's why you need to sort your action plan now. For further information go to your nearest fire station and get all the info you need for a safe summer.

In the first Total Fire Ban issued in September, crews from Kariong were sent to Wollombi as well as Cessnock to assist local crews in managing some serious fires in those districts.

During September Kariong RFB had their Get Ready Weekend down at Bunnings West Gosford. All reports from that indicate a very successful day with the guys & girls speaking to a lot of people and on top of that cooking up a storm with the sausage sizzle.

Finally, folks if you're in Food Works in Kariong and you see the "Big Red Extinguisher" money box, throw some loose change into it for our Santa Run lollies on Christmas Eve. It's for us to help everyone in Kariong have some Christmas cheer and put a smile on some kids faces.

That's it for now folks. Remember, stay safe and be Firewise.

Energy & Water Ombudsman NSW (EWON) – Busting Energy Myths

As well handling complaints from energy and water customers, EWON provides free advice and information, including how to safely save energy and water around the home.

Here are just a few of the energy saving myths we've busted for consumers.

MYTH: "Bring the BBQ inside for cooking and a bit of extra warmth".

BUSTED: It is really dangerous to use a gas or coal BBQ indoors for heating and cooking. Hot BBQs release carbon monoxide into the air and when this gas can't escape it becomes poisonous and could be deadly for you and your family.

MYTH: "A gas heater or even an oil column heater is cheaper than firing up the reverse cycle air con."

BUSTED: Not true. Reverse cycle air conditioning is the most efficient method of heating if you have it installed. Remember to seal drafts, only heat the rooms you're using and keep the temperature on your thermostat between 18-21°C in winter. Every degree outside of this range can add an extra 10% to your heating costs.

MYTH: "Using energy at night is always cheaper."

BUSTED: Using energy at night is only cheaper if you're on a time of use tariff. A time of use tariff means the price you'll be charged for electricity will vary depending on the time of day you use it. Your electricity bill should clearly state the type of tariff you're being charged. To find a tariff that's right for you see these tips from Energy Made Easy www.energymadeeasy.gov.au

MYTH: "I still have my 40-year-old Hallstrom refrigerator – what a great fridge!"

BUSTED: Unfortunately just because something was built to last doesn't mean it's energy efficient. Advances in technology mean that new appliances are likely to save you money in the long run.


