Autumn is here – get your homes ready for winter!

Keep the heat in by locating draughts and blocking them with door snakes, curtains and other seals.

Put on an extra layer of clothing or put another blanket on your bed to help keep you warmer in the cooler months.

Use your appliances efficiently by getting into good habits like turning them off at the wall when they're not in use. Standby power can account for more than 10% of your household energy use.

Hot or warm cycles on your washing machine use a lot of energy. Make significant savings by switching to cold water for laundry. And why not use nature's own dryer – the great outdoors? If the weather doesn't permit this, try drying your clothes in already heated rooms indoors.

The change of season is the perfect time to clean filters in your air conditioners to ensure they operate efficiently.

If you use an air conditioner for heating set the temperature to 18-21°C. Every degree outside this range can add up to 10% to your heating costs.

Counselling Services gambling HELP



Gambling and drinking often go together as people socialise. Research shows that there is a definite relationship between problem gambling and drinking alcohol.

Some people find that alcohol triggers them to gamble more than they can afford to lose. They take bigger risks and find it more difficult to stop gambling as inhibitions are lowered and decision making skills are impaired.

Some people also find that they drink more when they gamble as they are in the zone and not paying attention to how much they drink, and they celebrate wins or commiserate over losses.

If you think you are gambling and drinking too much first of all keep an accurate record of how much you are drinking and gambling, what venue you go to most, what time of day you go and what mood you are in when you chose to drink and gamble. Next set your limits – limit the amount of time you spend at the venue, limit how much money you take with you and limit the number of alcoholic drinks you consume.

If you feel you can't stick to these limits, consider taking a break from drinking and gambling for 2-6 weeks. If the idea of a break horrifies you, it may be a sign that you need professional support to develop deeper, more personalised strategies to overcome these habits.

G'Day folks.

Here's some more news from the Dandaloo St Fire Station. Well summer is having its last hurrah because as I sit & write, today is predicted to be a hot & blustery 38 degrees with a Total Fire Ban in place. As we move towards April, the Bushfire Danger Period will finish on March 31 however, I still need to tell you that it's not the time to let your guard down even though the weather is cooler.

Bushfires can happen anytime and that's something you need to be aware of. Another thing you need to be aware of and that's how cold it can get in Kariong and surrounding districts particularly if you're new to the area. Home heating whether it be electric blankets, heaters or even the humble fire place is an issue the fire services take very seriously and in the coming months you will notice a strong campaign to make the public aware of the dangers of badly maintained heating appliances and the need to keep an eye on these things particularly around kids.

Operationally, Kariong RFB has had a quite busy month with again motor vehicle accidents high on the list of occurrences. Folks, the message is clear & simple. Drive to the conditions and pay attention to what you're doing and your surroundings. The brigade will also be undertaking some renovations of our training area with some repainting and new flooring which should spruce the place up a bit.

Lastly, I want to raise the matter of joining the NSWRFS. Kariong RFB is always on the lookout for new members and the criteria for becoming a member couldn't be easier. Firstly, you need to live in the Kariong area. Secondly, have a need to do something for the local community. Thirdly, have the need to challenge yourself to learn a job that is both challenging and worthwhile. Once you join, you are provided with personal protective gear, training and potential to learn other new skills that will enhance you as a member of Kariong and the NSWRFS. Have a think about it.

That's it for now folks. Remember, stay safe and be Firewise.
