Responsible Gambling Awareness Week is held every year to raise awareness about the nature of gambling, the potential for harm, the importance of gambling responsibly, and where to get help if you run into a problem with gambling. This year it falls on 8–14 October.

Harm from gambling can cause significant damage to individuals, families, work places and communities. Some of the harms of problem gambling include financial stress, bankruptcy; relationship breakdown; mental and physical health problems such as depression, anxiety, ulcers, and high blood pressure; work absenteeism; social isolation; and suicidality.

People who gamble heavily are often stigmatised and feel great shame so unfortunately they don't seek help until they reach a crisis. The support of family and friends can make a major difference in helping people muster the strength to overcome their gambling problems. Talking about gambling helps make it okay for those affected to reach out and share the impact gambling may be having on their life.

We all need to look out for our mates who may be impacted by problem gambling. If you think someone may be struggling with gambling, either directly or as the result of their relationship with a person who gambles, take them aside for a chat and let them know that help is available.

Hi all,

It's time for more news from the Kariong Rural Fire Brigade.

Well the fire season has begun, all be it a month early. This season is shaping up to be a busy one for the Rural Fire Service across the state. With the current weather patterns and outlook for summer, fire danger and fire activity is likely to be high. With this said, now is the time to prepare your property and fire survival plans. You can also visit us at our station on a Saturday morning if you require guidance on preparing yourself and your property, one of our members will be happy to help.

Operationally the brigade has been very busy over the last month, attending a total of 44 incidents making it one of the busiest months in years. 21 of those calls were to bushfires, which is very unseasonable for this time of year. These statistics provide an outlook for the summer ahead. Please be very vigilant and remember to report any fires without a fire truck in attendance to 000.

As we approach summer, the brigade has been spending some time undertaking equipment checks and getting the trucks ready to respond to any fires in our area and surrounding areas. Fire fighting isn't always about attacking the hot stuff. Wednesday nights are often spent going over our equipment. If this sounds like something that interests you, please drop by our station on a Wednesday night or Saturday morning and have a chat about joining.

In other news, NSW had adopted a new road rule to help protect emergency service personnel while working on roadways. Please remember to slow down to 40KPH when passing an emergency vehicle displaying red and blue lights
