

As we come up to the Christmas gift giving season, many parents will be thinking about electronic purchases for their students, so I thought that I would just like to share a few thoughts from my perspective as an educator of more than 30 years, a parent and grandparent within our community.

Using electronic devices when young

There are many great programs available to download/buy for young children. Your child's world will be increasingly digitised, so starting off with controlled access to good quality material is probably going to become the norm. Starting with clearly defined time limits and restrictions on internet access when children are young is most likely to make setting the boundaries when students get older easier, as well.

Healthy body, healthy mind

We know that having a positive attitude to physical activity as a lifelong habit is essential for good health. Ensuring the balance between using devices and physical play is important for parents to embed into the daily routine. There is nothing wrong with playing electronic games, as long as this is done in moderation and complemented by physical activity (which doesn't have to be organised games – just riding your bike or going for a walk makes a difference).

And finally... cyber safety trumps privacy

Our children seem knowledgeable, but many are still quite naïve to the dangers of identity theft, hackers and dealing with emotions in the virtual world. Distinguishing between playing a game offline and being on the internet is important for parents to track. The younger the student, the less they should be in the online environment and the more closely its use should be scrutinised. Again, when controls are in place, it can be a rich experience and therefore setting up your rules early in their lives will lessen the battles as they get older.




