

#### High energy bills?

The Energy & Water Ombudsman NSW (EWON) provides the following information to help people experiencing difficulties with their energy bills.

High energy bills are one of the most common issues that EWON investigates. There are many factors that can contribute to an energy bill being higher than usual. A high bill is something out of the ordinary, taking into account your previous bills, the variations in your usage over the year and what you consider the amount your bills are normally.

If you think you will have trouble paying your bill, you should speak to your electricity or gas provider straight away. Your provider will work with you to offer an affordable payment plan or they may be able to invite you to participate in their financial assistance program. It's really important that you speak to your provider to avoid any missed payments that could lead to disconnection.

#### **High bill factors:**

- Does your bill include previous amounts you haven't paid?
- Has the price changed?
- Is your current bill estimated?
- Was your last bill under-estimated?

#### What contributes to a high bill?

- Seasonal factors using heating and cooling appliances such as an electric I heater or air conditioning.
- Over using household appliances like washing machines and clothes dryers.
- Running old or faulty large appliances such as a refrigerator.

#### Disputing a high bill

If you receive an unexpectedly high bill, contact your provider and talk to them about your concerns. You should ask your provider to explain the charges on your bill If your provider can't explain the charges on the bill to you straight away, they may offer to do a full investigation. If you are not happy with your provider's response, contact EWON on 1800 246 545 or visit ewon.com.au.





Mindfulness is the most effective method for overcoming unhelpful habits or addictions. Mindfulness involves being acutely aware of our thoughts, emotions, and actions. It means being present in each moment and paying close attention to what is happening in the present.

Let's say stress is a trigger that leads to behaviour such as eating chocolate. You eat it, it tastes good and you get a sugar rush. So the brain lays down a memory, 'Eating chocolate feels pretty good.' You learn to associate positive mood states with chocolate. If you are feeling stressed your brain says, "just eat chocolate and you'll feel better.' And so you form a habit of eating chocolate.

But eating chocolate isn't going to fix whatever is causing your stress. You might feel better in the short term, but in the long term eating chocolate can lead to obesity. Even knowing the negative consequences we get caught up in craving. We crave for pleasant feelings. We crave for unpleasant feelings to go away. The craving becomes intense and uncomfortable and you feel compelled to eat chocolate to make the discomfort go away.

But what if you sat with the craving; broke it down and saw it for what it really is. Try this Mindfulness exercise:

Relax and recognize that you're caught up in a craving.

Acknowledge, allow and accept that the craving is there.

Investigate 'what's happening in my body and mind right now?' Get really curious.

Notice non-judgmentally whatever body sensations and feelings are present in any one moment.

If you follow the R.A.I.N. process you'll see that the thoughts and sensations are bearable. They come and go. They're not going to last forever. They're not permanent. You don't have to get sucked into them. The spell is broken and with practice you are freed from habit.

# Standpipe



G'Day all.

Here's some more chatter from Kariong Rural Fire Brigade. Well, as promised the cold weather really hit with temperatures dropping into the mid to low 'teens and I'm pretty sure I could smell the smoke from a few fire places being lit up for the first time this year. Folks, this is just the tip of the iceberg (so to speak) for Kariong as the weather services are predicting a cold winter and the fire services across the state are pushing the same message. That is to be prepared by checking your heaters, fire places, electric blankets and what ever else keeps you warm AND YOUR **SMOKE DETECTOR** for serviceability and operation. **DO NOT** leave it to chance because winter is notorious for house fires where faulty heating appliances fail or malfunction and blocked or badly cleaned fireplace flues catch fire. Whilst we're on the subject of fireplaces, don't be tempted to burn rubbish as an easy way of disposing of it. Rubbish smoke has a very distinctive smell and if you're caught you can expect a bit of hot water from the EPA or Council so be warned.

You'll probably notice a bit of smoke about too as the NSWRFS along with Fire Rescue NSW and National Parks conduct hazard reduction burns when the weather permits in strategic areas. As always, if you see an unattended fire without any appliances nearby, give Triple Zero a buzz and report it.

Work on the stations training room refurb is coming along with members getting into the task lead by our own **Mick Hughes** and **Don Simpson**. Mick putting in extra hours on top of his regular job being a carpenter/ joiner during the week. Flooring for the training room was organised by **Rebecca Ball** a brigade member. Flooring was generously supplied by **Shaw Contracting Group** and installed by **Peter Gowans**, Becs Father, of **Midtown Commercial Flooring Contractors**.

During May, Kariong was invited to participate at a Family Fun night at Bunnings West Gosford. Along with Fire Rescue NSW Umina Station, we pushed the winter fire safety message as well as looking after your smoke detector. There were quite a few people attending and by all accounts it was a successful night.
