Langford Drive / Woy Woy Road intersection: the report prepared for Gosford Council has been completed, and the cost of traffic lights is just under \$8 million dollars!!!

The reality is that no Government is going to provide that amount of funding, and an alternative plan was suggested, a set of controlled pedestrian lights near Milyerra Road for safe crossing, plus a right-turn bay into Woy Woy Road from Langford Drive. A meeting took place between Gosford Council staff, and members of the Association on 3 February, and Council staff have gone back to cost the alternative plan. The funding already approved by Lucy Wicks, Federal Member for Robertson remains available.

<u>Mt. Penang Development Plan</u>: expressions of interest have been called for this site, and applications close on 12 March. Applications will be assessed by the Central Coast Regional Development group, before submission to Gosford Council for approval. More information as it comes to hand.

<u>Tennis Courts</u>: both Courts are now fully functional. To make a booking you can contact Yvonne on 4340 1068, between 8.30am and 6.30pm.

<u>CCTV cameras for Kariong</u>: the installation of the cameras will be delayed until all new cameras for the Central Coast are determined, so that the process can be completed as one package.

Fee changes as at 1st March 2015

A reminder following information given in the last newsletter, all Doctors will be privately billing patients from 1st March 2015. Children <u>under 16</u> will continue to be bulk billed. If you are on a concession /pension card the decision on whether you are privately billed or bulk billed will be up to your Doctor on the day. All patients are asked to please come to the surgery prepared to pay for their consultation. Eftpos facility is available as well as online claiming to Medicare. Please register your bank account details with Medicare for the rebate to be paid to you within 24 hours, otherwise you will receive a cheque in the mail.

Non Attendance of appointments

Unfortunately, over the last few months there has been an exceptional amount of patients who have not attended their booked appointment at the surgery. If this trend continues, a non-attendance fee will have to be introduced.

Patients are asked to please cancel a booked appointment with as much notice as possible if you are unable to attend.

Patients are reminded to ask the receptionist for a longer appointment if you have forms to be filled out, or multiple or complicated issues to discuss with your Doctor. This will help us keep our appointments running to time. We appreciate it when you arrive on time for your scheduled appointment, however, expect that there are times when Doctors do run late due to emergencies on the day.
