Somersby Veterinarian Dr Robin Crisman's affection for animals as a child was always going to land her in veterinary medicine.

This month, the Australian Small Animal Veterinarians Association (ASAV) recognised Dr Crisman as the 2019 National Practitioner of the Year. According to ASAV, The Practitioner of the Year "has rendered outstanding service to the profession and the public in terms of academic qualifications, standard of practice, professional profile, altruism or all of these components".

But it is not only her peers who admire Dr Crisman's work, fellow Somersby Animal Hospital Director, Gabriela Dahmen, says her customers absolutely love her too.

Gabriela Dahmen nominated Dr Crisman in secret, so the award was a complete surprise. Although proud, Dr Crisman remains incredibly humble, saying that to receive the award was special, but that at the heart of it she just loves her work.

Classic Sultana Cake

375g sultanas
1 tbsp brandy
250g butter at room temperature
1 cup caster sugar
zest of 1 lemon
3 eggs
375g plain flour
1 1/2 tsp baking powder
2/3 cup (170ml) buttermilk

Mix the sultanas and brandy in a bowl. Cover and leave overnight.

Preheat the oven to 150 degrees C. Grease a 20cm cake tin and line the base and sides with baking paper.

Beat the butter, caster sugar and lemon zest with an electric mixer until light and creamy, at least 5 minutes.

Add the eggs one at a time, beating after each addition.

Sift the flour and baking powder together. Use 1 tbsp of the flour to dust the sultanas so they don't sink to the bottom of the cake.

Fold the sultanas into the creamed mixture, then add the flour alternately with the buttermilk.

Spoon into prepared pan and smooth the surface. Tap hard on the bench to settle the mix and remove air bubbles.

Bake on the second shelf from the bottom for $2 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ hours or until golden on top and firm to a gentle touch. Leave to cool in the tin.

Best made at least a day ahead of time, this cake will keep in the fridge for up to a week.



The Central Coast group of the Australian Plants Society will present a demonstration on how to grow **Waratahs and Flannel Flowers** from seed and cuttings at 7.30 pm on Friday 11 October at Phillip House, 21 Old Mt Penang Road, Kariong, as part of its regular monthly meeting.


