#### Flu Vaccine has arrived.

If you are eligible for the free vaccine and you have been to the centre in the last 3 months you can make a Fluvax only appointment with the Doctor to have the flu vaccine on the day your usual GP is available.

## Eligible groups for free government supplied seasonal influenza vaccine

- 65 years of age and over
- Pregnant women at any stage of pregnancy
- Indigenous people 15 years of age and over

• Residents of nursing homes and other long-term care facilities

• Any person 6 months of age and over with a chronic condition predisposing to severe influenza illness that requires regular medical follow-up or hospitalisation such as:

- o cardiac disease
- o respiratory disease including severe asthmatics
- o kidney disease
- o diabetes
- o impaired immunity
- o neuromuscular disease
- o Homeless people.

#### If you are <u>not eligible</u> for the free vaccine you will need to make an appointment to see your GP for a Prescription.



G Day all; I'm back with some news from Kariong Rural Fire Brigade for this month. Well, I've got to put in some apologies for missing the last two issues. I had some house moving to do...you know what it's like. Anyway lets get on with it shall we?

Over the past couple of months we've experience the best Mother Nature could offer. Bushfires in January, awesome storms and wild weather in February which really kept the brigade hopping from one job to another. The stats for last month were: 8 motor vehicle accidents. 1 bush alight. 4 vehicle fires. 3 structure fires. 6 storm assistance. 1 gas leak. 7 Automatic Fire Alarms. Totalling 31 calls but with several jobs bunched together whilst assisting with storm damage, the total came close to 40! So as you can see folks, your local brigade has been quite busy. It's been a real credit to the group and an extraordinary test of the depth of the membership to maintain this level of operations in such a busy time. Remember folks, these guys are volunteers who have jobs and other commitments to attend to so they were all stretched to their limits but were happy to do so in assisting the community. That's what the RFS is all about guys...for the community. The guys had our vehicles as well as our Community Education trailer and from all reports, spoke to quite a few members of the public about Firewise programs and bushfire survival as well as the Prepare Act Survive program. Just remember folks that although we've had a fair bit of rain and stormy weather, we're still in "fire season" That means that all the conditions attached to the bushfire danger period are still in force 'till March 31<sup>st</sup>. Remember, if you're not sure what you are able to do, give the District Office a call.

Ok folks, that's about it for now. Remember, stay safe and be Firewise.


