Although at the time of publication, Refugee Week has passed by for 2017, I wanted to share with you a newsletter article that I wrote for our parent community as it reinforces one of the values that are core to our school - UNITY.

Refugee Week and Shakespeare

The theme for the 2017 Refugee Week (June 18 - 24) celebration is "with courage let us all combine" taken from the second verse of our national anthem. In other words, UNITY, one of our three core values.

As cited on the <u>refugeeweek.org.au</u> website, this theme is about celebrating the courage of refugees and those that speak out about persecution and injustice and a call for all Australians to show unity and take positive action in welcoming refugees to our great country. We are a lucky country and have the capacity to be compassionate to those who do not have the quality of life that we enjoy. The strength and value of our public education system is that it welcomes all and embraces diversity. We are all the same under the skin and there is no place for put downs based on differences.

Which brings me to Shakespeare? At the time of his writing, there were concerns amongst the workers of London about jobs being lost due to the influx of 'refugees' and there were intolerances to those who were not of the Queen's faith (sound familiar?). Shakespeare's writing shows that he did not agree with these views and, in fact, tried to educate people with his words. I think that is one reason why Shakespeare still has relevance today, across all cultures.

In the words of Shylock:

"I am a Jew. Hath not a Jew eyes? Hath not a Jew hands, organs, dimensions, senses, affections, passions; fed with the same food, hurt with the same weapons, subject to the same diseases, heal'd by the same means, warm'd and cool'd by the same winter and summer, as a Christian is? If you prick us, do we not bleed? If you tickle us, do we not laugh? If you poison us, do we not die? And if you wrong us, do we not revenge? If we are like you in the rest, we will resemble you in that.

The Merchant Of Venice Act 3, scene 1, 58-68

His point? We are all human, with the same needs and wants. He wanted people to see that differences are a state of mind and that we are more alike than different. This message of tolerance and acceptance, written so long ago, is still the same message we want our students to understand and embrace today; let us truly accept the bounty that we get from being both a multicultural society and one that welcomes refugees to our shores.





Here's a bit more news from the Dandaloo Street fire station for this month.

A little while ago, I was discussing with you about what an exciting time it is to join the NSWRFS. Things are really moving with the Service locally with Gosford fire district now amalgamated with Wyong and The Lakes to form a new zone now called Central Coast District. You'll still be able to access all your face to face information through the district office on Woy Woy Road or any RFS fire station as usual but the Service locally will be more centralised and consolidated. So, if you've ever entertained thoughts of joining the NSWRFS then here's the tip; come up and see us. That's right! We're open Saturday mornings from 8am and Wednesday evenings from 7.30pm. So just pop up to the Station in Dandaloo Street Kariong and the guys there will be more than happy to see you.

Operationally speaking, Kariong had 28 incidents ranging from smoke sightings, automatic fire alarms and motor vehicle accidents or MVA's. Once again MVA's topped the list particularly when the wet weather hit. Folks, the message hasn't changed and that is, drive to the conditions and slowdown in the wet.

Currently, the fire services are talking up the issue of being vigilant around the home when it comes to cooking and heating. I can't say it any more clearer about when cooking meals and that is pay attention to what you're doing and by that, I mean don't leave things on the stove while you're checking your status updates on the internet. And keep an eye on your other heating gear such as electric blankets and wood heaters. Make sure they are up to the task and supervise kids around these devices.

Lastly, there has been an issue of parking around the fire station. If you are in Dandaloo Street for any reason please don't park your car on the station's driveway especially where it says, "No Parking" It's a bit of a nobrainer really but you'd be surprized what happens.

Ok folks, that's it for this month. Remember, stay safe and be Firewise.






