

Another advantage of bringing our seniors and youth together is that it demystifies each group and as a result such knowledge can have a positive flow on effect about what happens in our community and the interactions each group has with the other.

Youth week celebrates the potential of our young people to take on their roles as the future leaders of our society. As noted in the NBN news clip last month, we have some fantastic ambassadors for leadership at our school and they have developed these skills through our leadership and academic programs. At school, we often see this potential being realised, in formal settings such as peer support and the leadership team, but also in informal ways, when students volunteer to support particular charities, help out friends in need and work together within their classes to help everyone achieve more, not just themselves.

Sometimes our focus on negative behaviours, leads to the positive behaviours being forgotten. There are more reasons to praise our youth, than damn them. I don't have 'rose tinted glasses' about youth, I have the experience of working with them every school day and I continue to be proud and optimistic about what the students of Kariong Mountains High School will go on to achieve.



G'day folks. Here's some more news from Kariong Rural Fire Brigade for this month.



As I mentioned last issue we're moving into Autumn and the RFS will be conducting hazard reduction burns throughout the district and outlying areas. Crews will be out and about carrying out this work whilst the weather is favourable. So you may see a little smoke about but if you've got any concerns give the local Fire Control Centre a call on 43402911 and as always, if you see an unattended fire call 000.

Also, just a reminder about home safety and the things you can do to help best protect you. Folks, I can't make it any clearer that safety in the home where heating appliances are concerned is a vitally important matter for you to keep in mind. I can tell you from experience that Kariong can be bitterly cold in winter and you need to be on your toes with your heating appliances particularly where there are kids involved. To an adult if something doesn't look right they'll more than likely put it aside for checking or repair later. Generally speaking, kids don't have that cognitive skill and will do things that "mum & dad do" albeit slightly different.


Here's an example. Years ago I knew a family in Kariong & they had two littlies. Every morning the eldest would get up & go to the lounge room and mum would put the heater and telly on. On this particular morning "little miss" went out as usual however, mum decided to have a lay in so "little miss" thinking herself a "big girl" duly put the heater & telly on by herself. Being a rather chilly morning "little miss" pulled the heater closer and closer to the lounge until it was almost touching the fabric. Dad, who was home that morning started to smell the acrid smell of burning material foam. He jumped out of bed along with mum and made it to the lounge room just in time to see the lounge slowly smouldering away with "little miss" still sitting on it. Another minute or two and it would have caught fire.

Folks, that's how easy it can happen so please do your checks with electric blankets, heaters and so on and most importantly, supervise your kids around them. DO NOT leave things to chance.

Just a reminder folks that the fire station is open for training Wednesday nights from 7.30pm and Saturday mornings from 8.00am. We're in Dandaloo Street Kariong so if you're keen to come up and see us, please do. We'd be most happy to have a chat with you about joining the Service and brigade.

Australian Academy of Tai Chi



An Antidote for Anxious Children and Teens

Recently through the media, attention has been drawn to some disturbing problems facing Central Coast children and teens: increasingly, parents and teachers are reporting signs and symptoms of stress and anxiety in young people. The causes of this problem are no doubt complex, and the author is not inclined to give extended commentary here, however an anxious child, teen, and young adult myself, I understand too well the cage of limitations that anxiety creates.

Along the way, the antidote I stumbled across, for me, was tai chi - a moving meditation and exercise that I have come to believe so strongly in as a holistic health practice, that I pursued the in-depth training needed to become an instructor. Regular practice helped me to the point that I now have no problem standing in front of large groups of people to demonstrate the methods learned. So what is tai chi and how can this ancient practice help today's stressed and anxious youth?

Most people nowadays recognise there is a strong mind-body connection; neither exists in isolation. Whether it is the mind playing tricks on the body with the 'placebo effect', or stomach butterflies when you are feeling nervous, most acknowledge that the mind can lead the body to feel certain ways. Many are not aware however, that this process can also work in reverse; the body can also exert some control over the mind.

In tai chi, we use sequenced, precise, slow-flowing movements and diaphragmatic breathing to release tension from the body, and also send feedback to the brain that we are safe, calm, and relaxed. This short circuits the vicious cycle of our 'fight or flight' response and quells the cause of anxiety at the source. It is a powerful technique.

Adapted from martial arts, the movements are fun and enjoyable for children to perform. At its deeper levels, tai chi draws from the Taoist philosophies of 'going with the flow' and finding balance in all things helpful messages for over stressed teens. Ultimately, tai chi gives children a 'toolbox' of techniques which can be used to find calmness anytime they are feeling nervous or anxious.

I am currently seeking interest in a children and teens tai chi course to run in Kariong.

Responsible Gambling Awareness Week (RGAW) falls on the 23-29 of this month. RGAW is all about raising awareness of the free Gambling Help counselling services and support tools available for people experiencing gambling problems, and this year the theme is Family and Friends.

The theme was chosen for two important reasons. The support of family and friends can make a major difference in helping problem gamblers muster the strength to overcome their gambling addiction. At the same time an estimated ten other people can be negatively affected by one person's gambling problem – not only partners and family but also workmates and friends. People often don't realise they are able to access free support as well.

One of the biggest challenges facing family and friends is how to raise the issue of problem gambling. It can be a very awkward thing to do. People are often afraid that mentioning someone's gambling problem may damage their relationship.

In response, Gambling Help is launching an animated e-card campaign, Talkward, to help break through any stigma and encourage dialogue and support from family and friends. The e-cards, which can be found at www.talkward.com.au, can be customised and personalised, then emailed to a person to humorously focus on a thorny subject but carry a serious message: "Now we've got the awkward bit out of the way, let's have a talk in real life."

We are also launching a free self-help booklet for family and friends which has a wealth of information on how to protect yourself financially and emotionally and how to assist loved ones with their problem. 


