Hello from the desk of the Standpipe



Our call outs from 19th March 2015 to 15th April 2015 were a total of 30

Calls – False Alarms x 3, Fire & Explosions x 5, Good Intent x 1, Hazardous Conditions x 2, MVA/Rescue/EMS x 16 and Service Calls x 3.

As you can see we attended 16 motor vehicle accidents in the month. We have had some shocking weather of late. Rain, thunderstorms, fog, trees fallen across roads etc. Poor visibility and not driving to the conditions of the day may result in an accident. Be aware of the other vehicles on the road as they may make a wrong judgement. Safety is always a priority for example turning you headlights on in the rain, securing your pets in the vehicle, no not use your mobile phone.

In preparation for the fire season commencing on the 1st October the Brigade would like to update its records of the static water supply (SWS) properties in our area. What is this you may ask? If your property has a swimming pool, tanks, dams, ponds, creeks or any other large container of water that could be used in case of a fire. A SWS indicator plate is fixed in a location on your property to be highly visible from the road. More than likely near your letter box. Kariong Progress

We have a new State representative in Parliament. Following the election five weeks ago, the seat of Gosford changed hands from Liberal to Labor and the new Member for Gosford is Kathy Smith. The former State Liberal MP Chris Holstein lost the seat by less than 200 votes with a 12.2% swing to Labor after ten days of counting in the closest contest in Gosford's political history. At the Kariong Public School booth, Holstein's 1,337 votes shaded Smith's 1,054 votes; but the swings elsewhere in this marginal electorate were enough to ensure that Labor will represent our Kariong residents in Parliament for the next four years.

One achievement of the previous government just before the election was to purchase the majority of the Bambara land (just south of Kariong) for incorporating into Brisbane Water National Park. The protection of the land from unwanted development and improved bio-security was a high priority for local community and Aboriginal groups who worked with Council, Chris Holstein and the private land owners to secure it. It took more than two years to do it but the purchase of lots 229, 251, 478 and 2502 is now being finalised by the Office of Environment and Heritage.

Modern closed circuit television cameras are coming soon to four locations in Kariong — around the skate park, the two shopping centre carparks and The Hill Youth Centre carpark. Progress representatives attended an on-site meeting in mid-March to identify the most useful positions for the cameras and Council's project, supported by a Federal grant, should be completed this month.

Council is not prepared to clean the extensive graffiti over the surface of the skate park because cleaning may affect the integrity of the concrete surface. No anti-graffiti paint was ever used there. Progress is writing to Council to explore this issue further.

Expressions of interest in developing Mt Penang's Highway Precinct (Precinct 6) closed nearly two months ago and the CCRDC is now culling and assessing a few of the proposals. All land and buildings at Mt Penang have been leased up to now but the State Corporation claims to reserve the right to sell land there too. Progress is keeping a watching brief on any development applications in Council for this land.

The weather in Kariong is mostly pleasant these days — not too cold yet and not too hot. Why not get out, be active and consider a game of tennis? To make a tennis booking (day or night), phone Yvonne on 4340 1068 but only between 8:30am and 6:30pm.


