members stay safe and reduce the likelihood of them becoming victims of opportunistic crime.

### Safety at home

If you are harassed, attacked or robbed, tell the police immediately

Lock all doors when you are at home Leave spare keys with a trusted friend rather than hiding them

Keep a photographic record of your jewellery and engrave valuable personal items with your name, address and license number

If you are going away ask a trusted neighbour to keep an eye on your home and collect your mail Don't keep large amounts of money in the home Make sure your house number is clearly visible to ensure police can locate your home quickly if you need assistance

If you live alone, don't publicise this

Do not publicise whether you are Ms, Miss, Mrs or Mr Arrange to have regular contact with someone you trust.

### Visitors

If you are not sure who it is, don't open the door Remember if it seems to good to be true, it probably is

Be suspicious of people wanting to enter your home. Ask for identification, look at it carefully and contact their office for verification If someone wants to use your phone for an emergency, offer to make the call for them, but don't let them in.

## The Impact of the Connected World on Learning

When we picture a quality learning environment, we tend to picture our own classroom experience (sometimes with rose tinted glasses). Yet, when we consider our twenty first century lifestyle and the technologies we take for granted, the classrooms of our youth are not necessarily providing students with the skills they will need to be successful leaders of their own learning. Make no mistake, that is one of our goals at Kariong Mountains High School.

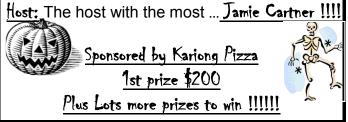
The modern world is a connected one – knowledge is shared (you can go to Youtube and learn how to sew on a button!); connectivity is lateral not a hierarchy, meaning that knowledge from teachers, parents, professors... is not always given more respect than knowledge from peers, and with increasing globalisation our students will need to be more proficient in working across cultures (and this means more than just learning 'a language other than English', although this can still be helpful).

It is my belief that learning in the twenty first century is more blended than at any other time. Instead, we should recognise it for its position in students' lives and help them to learn from it wisely. It is the challenge and excitement of how to do this, that underpins much of the professional learning undertaken by teachers. If we can help students to be leaders of their own learning, then they will have the resilience required to stand on their own and reach for their dreams.

At Kariong Mountains High School, we recognise that you can learn from the past, but to support students as leaders we have to also equip them with 'the skills necessary to be successful citizens in an ever changing society'. Our school operates with a future focused approach, learning from the past, but challenging ourselves to be responsive to the world we actually live in.

The air is a little crisper, the trees are changing colour, mornings are brighter and evenings arrive sooner. With the change in our physical seasons we sometimes hear the term Flu season, welcome to it!

As a result of the new season, we are experiencing an increased demand for appointments.

Please phone and advise staff if you are unable to attend an appointment, so this appointment can be given to another person. We apologise if you have had difficulty getting an appointment recently, but we are doing our very best to accommodate your needs.

We also have a cancellation list which is triaged throughout the day when cancellations arise.

### Seasonal Flu

Each year flu affects thousands of people. You can help reduce the spread of flu by taking a few simple precautions:

- Make sure that you and your family are vaccinated against flu each year
- Take time off work and avoid groups of people if you have flu-like symptoms
- Wash your hands frequently and cover coughs and sneezes.
- Covering coughs and sneezes and using disposable tissues instead of a hanky.
- Wearing a mask, when requested, to protect others in the community.

## Colds or Flu

Sorting out whether you are suffering from a simple cold or flu can be confusing. Influenza is a serious illness and many people who think or say they are suffering from influenza, just have a cold that that will quickly resolve itself.

### Key flu symptoms include:

A fever that generally lasts for several days. Chills and sweating A dry, sore throat Weakness and muscle and joint pain Headache A dry cough

Colds symptoms can be different, in that :

Symptoms generally only last a couple of days A cold usually starts with a runny nose People with a cold don't usually have muscle pains and shivers

A mild fever can develop, but usually only lasts a day.

Check your gas connections that there isn't a gas leak and if you have an open fire remove all the soot and debris from the flue.

Make sure you don't place anything in front or on top of heaters that could catch alight. Educate your children on the dangers of heaters and getting too close.

Have you replaced your smoke alarm battery yet? It's always a good idea to check your smoke detector is working properly once a month. It only takes a second or two, a broom stick and a pair of ears. Remember, it could save your family's lives.

Since February 19 until 16<sup>th</sup> April, the Brigade has been called to 38 calls. 10 of those were to Fire and or Explosions, 10 were Good Intent Calls and 8 were MVAs. Well done and thanks to the amazing crews that have attended these calls. Some in the early hours of the morning. The pager goes off, they fly out of bed, head to the station – sometimes still in their PJs, don on their gear and jump in the truck. These men and women have such a strong commitment to protect their Community.

This week we have visited three early learning centres in Kariong and around the District. The kids love seeing the big red truck. We have a quick chat to them about fire in the home, the need to know their address and what to do if there is a fire. Then the children have a turn to get dressed up in a jacket and helmet, sit in the truck and use the hoses to wet some trees, or today, it was the Teacher's cars and a couple of the Crew. Overall the Children, Teachers and Crew thoroughly enjoy the experience.
