Date Loaf

1 ½ cup chopped dates
¾ cup sugar
115g butter, at room
temperature
½ tsp bicarbonate of soda

1 cup boiling water

1 egg

1 3/4 cup self-raising flour

1 tsp ground cinnamon



Method

Heat oven 160°C. Grease a loaf tin and line the base with baking paper.

Place dates, sugar, butter and bicarb in a bowl and add the cup of boiling water.

Set aside to cool to just warm. Add the egg, lightly beaten, sifted flour and cinnamon, and stir into the wet ingredients until fully combined.

Pour into the cake tin and smooth the top. Bake for 50 to 60 minutes or until the cake feels firm to a gentle touch in the centre. Cool for 10 minutes in tin before turning out onto a tea towel covered cake rack.

Current best practice teaching in our classrooms is only a part of the recipe for success. Wellbeing/health has to also be at the front and centre of success and it is in this space, that although school plays an important role, it is parents who lead the way. Two important aspects of good health that parents can monitor/influence to help improve success at school are:

- Nutrition healthy bodies, healthy minds (we have a healthy canteen strategy, but a number of students come to school with soft drinks and snacks from stopping off at the shops in the morning).
- Sleep teenagers should get about 9 hours of sleep a night (i.e. asleep, not just in their bedroom).

Naturally, being active is also a key aspect and again we can both facilitate this. For example, through organising play and sport programs at school and at home, or through scheduling time away from electronic devices. Educating students at school goes hand in hand with educating children in families. They are not two discrete parts of a child's life and the best outcomes are achieved with working together. Thank you to all the families with whom we have this great connection.

45-49 Year Old Health Checks

As we get older, many of us become more vulnerable to illness. To reduce this, we would like to invite you to make an appointment to come into the Kariong Medical Centre for a health check. It is for everyone aged between 45 and 49 who may be at risk of developing a health complaint, like diabetes or heart problems.

The aim of the health check is to help find, prevent or lessen the effect of disease. After all, it is better to avoid disease than treat it. This health check will give us the opportunity to look at your lifestyle and medical/family history to find out if you are at risk.

Risk factors may include high blood pressure, lack of physical activity, extra weight, unbalanced diet, high cholesterol, family history of disease (e.g. cancer, heart diseases or diabetes) and smoking. There is no cost for this service as it is covered by Medicare.

When booking your appointment, please advise the reception staff that it is for a 45-49 Year Old Health Check so they can allocate enough time for the nurse and doctor to see you.


What's on at Kariong library?
